### Smoking and Pregnancy

**Births affected by smoking** **33**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function*

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$44,814**

**Percent of pregnant women who smoke:**  
Indiana: **11.8%**  
Sullivan County: **18.9%**

**Deaths attributable to smoking** **34**

**Deaths due to secondhand smoke** **5**
