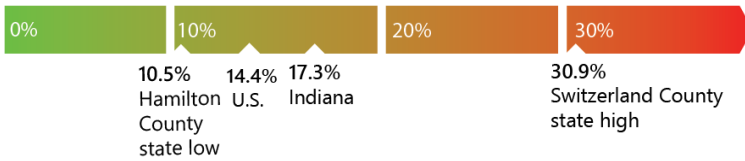

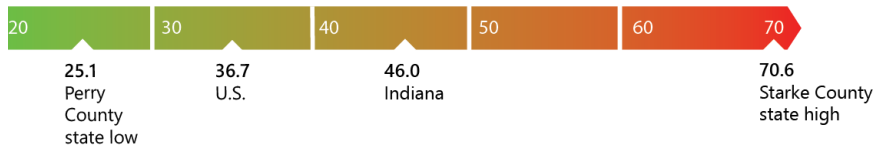

Tobacco and Health in Tippecanoe County

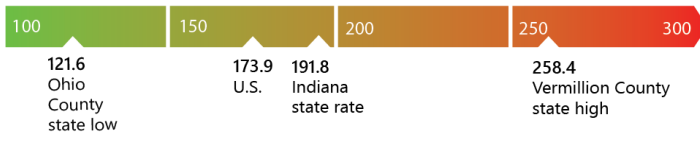
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **14.9%**



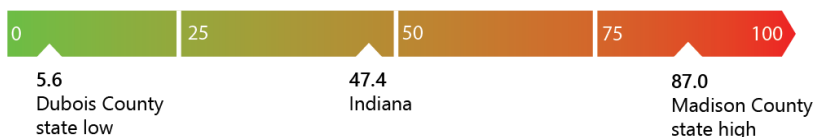
