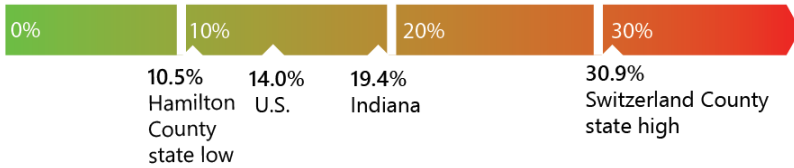


The state of tobacco control Tippecanoe County

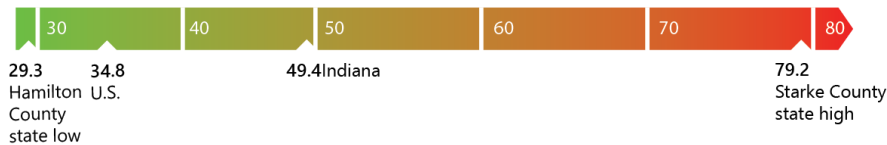
There is no tobacco control grant in Tippecanoe County for 2021-2023.
