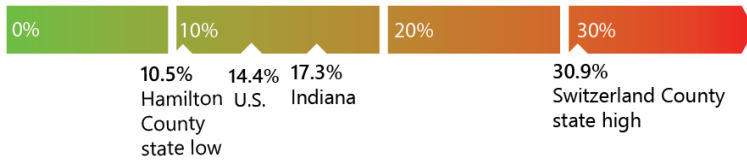

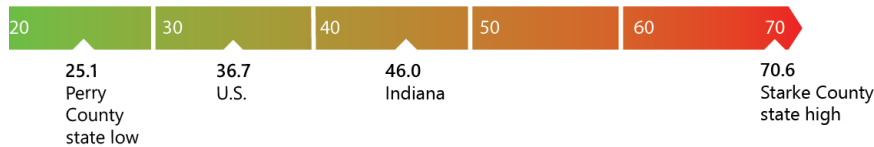

Tobacco and Health in Tipton County

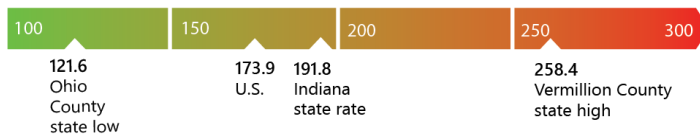
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **26.1%**



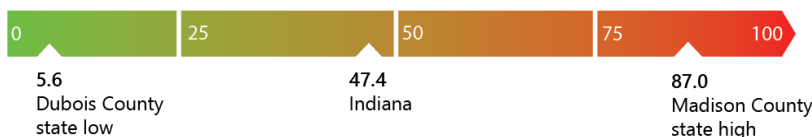
