## Smoking and Pregnancy

**Births affected by smoking** **215**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function*

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$291,970**

**Percent of pregnant women who smoke:**  
Indiana: **11.8%**  
Vigo County: **18.1%**

**Deaths attributable to smoking** **174**

**Deaths due to secondhand smoke** **28**
