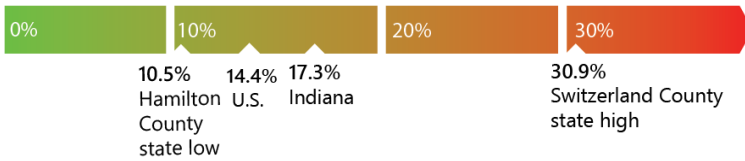

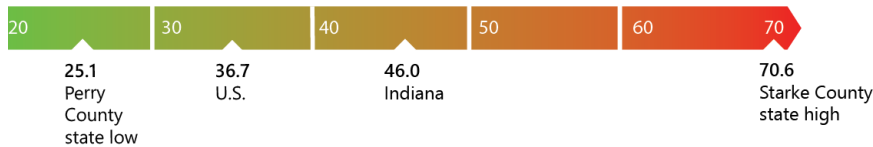

## Tobacco and Health in Warrick County

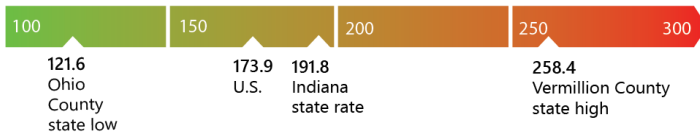
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **14.8%**



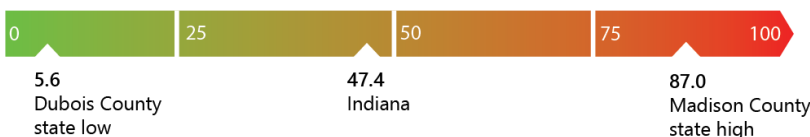
 **Lung cancer deaths**
