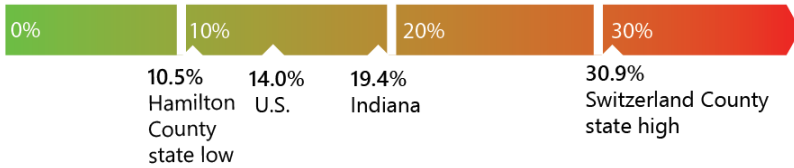

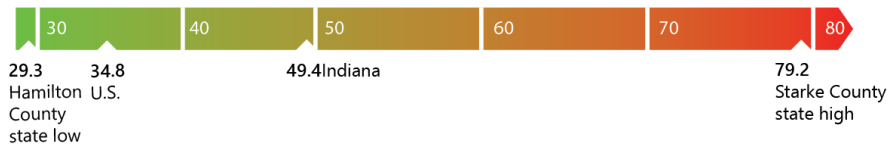
There is no tobacco control grant in Wayne County for 2021-2023.

Births affected by smoking **139**
low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function

Cost of smoking related births **\$188,762**

Deaths attributable to smoking **109**

Deaths due to secondhand smoke **17**
