

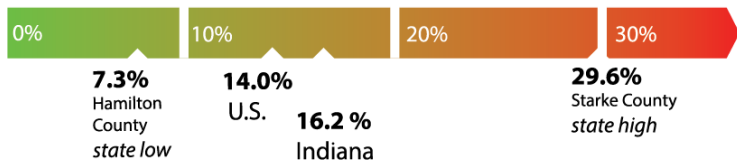

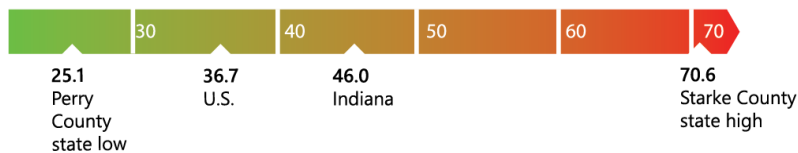

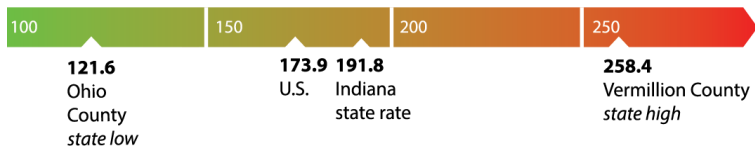
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **17.1%**



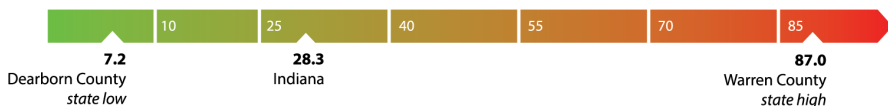
 **Lung cancer deaths** **45.0**
