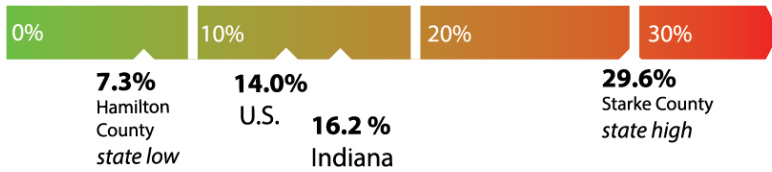

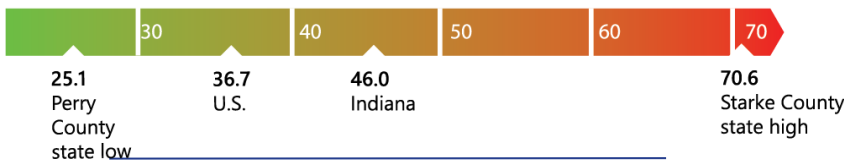
There is no tobacco control grant in Carroll County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Carroll County

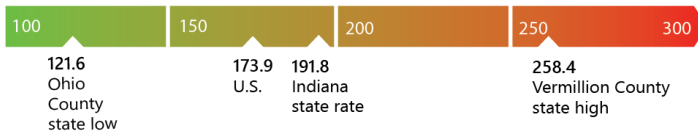
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.7%**



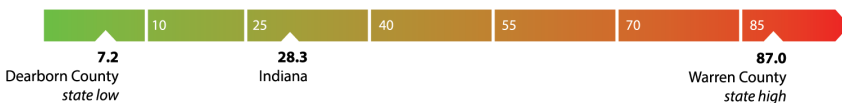
 **Lung cancer deaths** **49.8**
