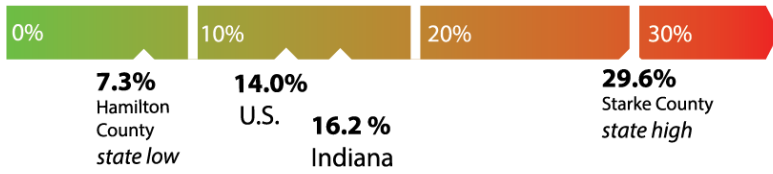


The state of tobacco control in DeKalb County

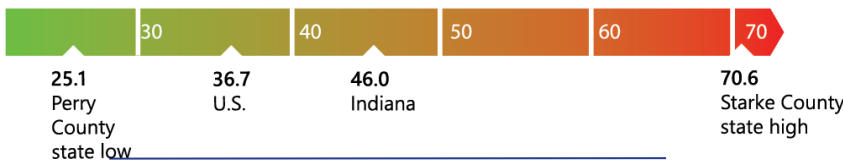
There is no tobacco control grant in DeKalb County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in DeKalb County

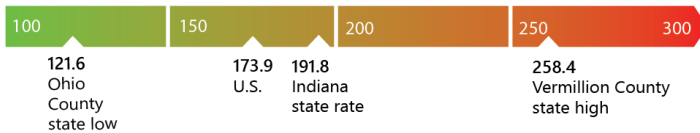
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **18.5%**



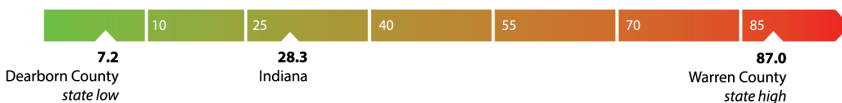
