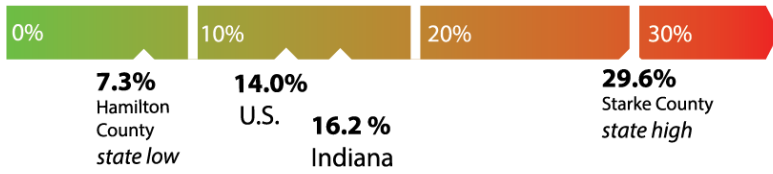


# The state of tobacco control in Dubois County

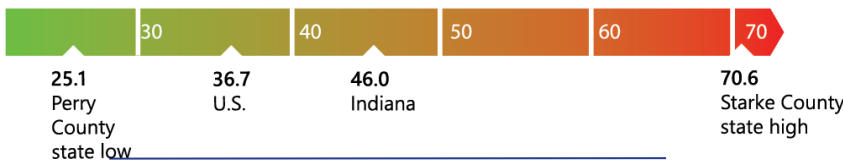
There is no tobacco control grant in Dubois County for 2023-2025.

## Tobacco and Health in Dubois County

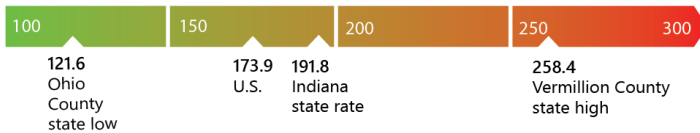
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **17.0%**



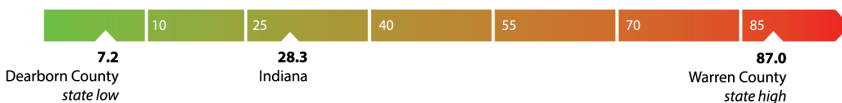
