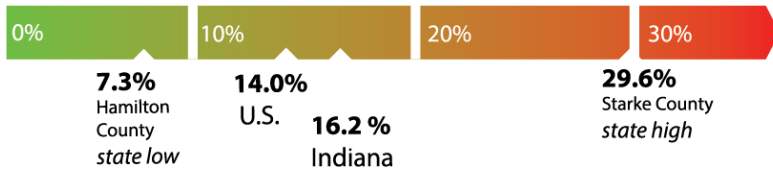


# The state of tobacco control in Fayette County

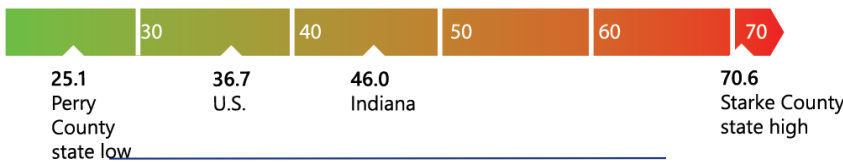
There is no tobacco control grant in Fayette County for 2023-2025.

## Tobacco and Health in Fayette County

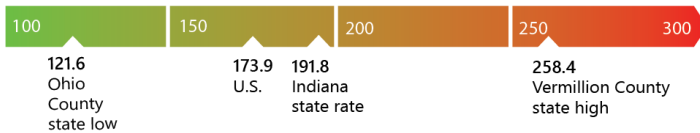
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **26.2%**



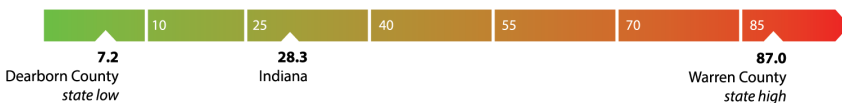
 **Lung cancer deaths** **54.6**
