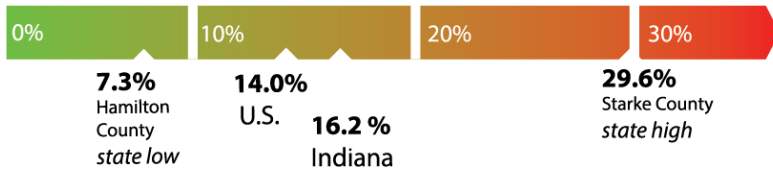


The state of tobacco control in Hendricks County

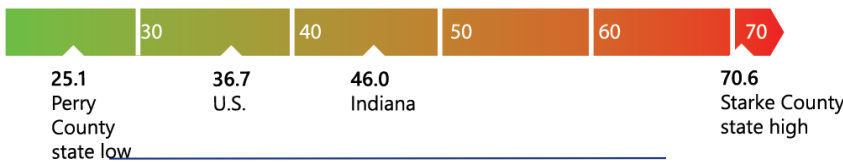
There is no tobacco control grant in Hendricks County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Hendricks County

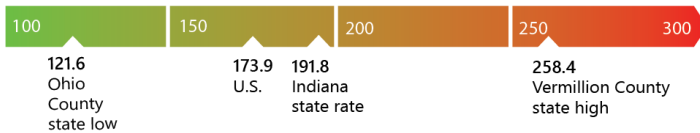
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **13.6%**



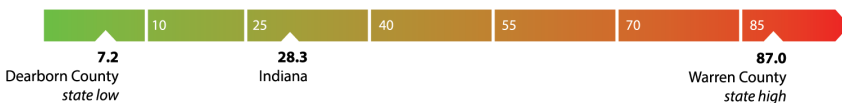
