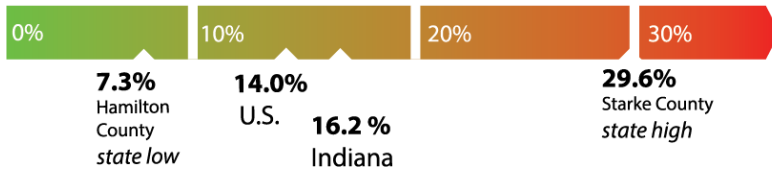

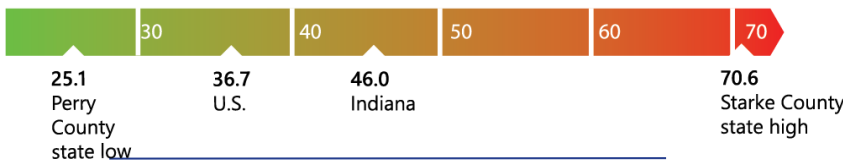

Tobacco and Health in Jackson County

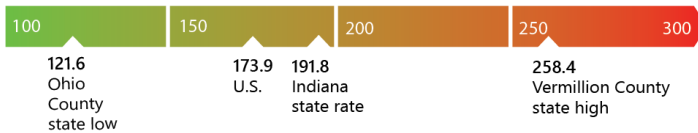
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **19.2%**



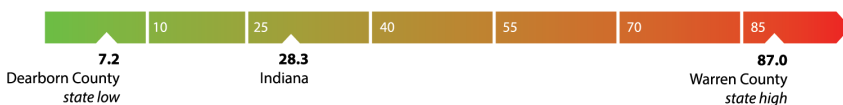
 **Lung cancer deaths** **52.1**
