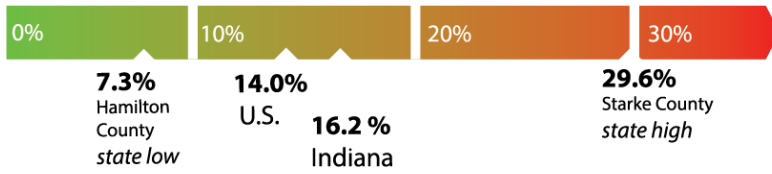


The state of tobacco control in Jay County

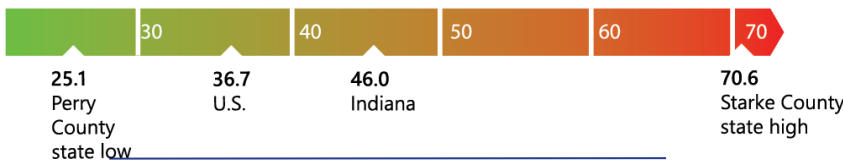
There is no tobacco control grant in Jay County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Jay County

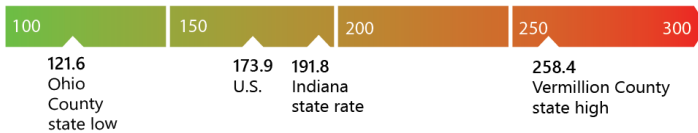
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.3%**



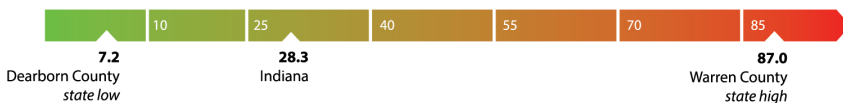
