

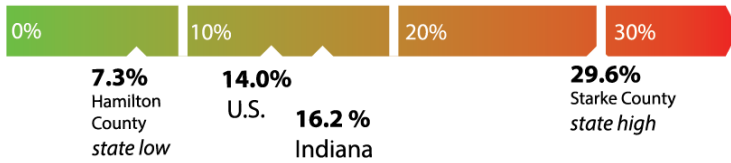

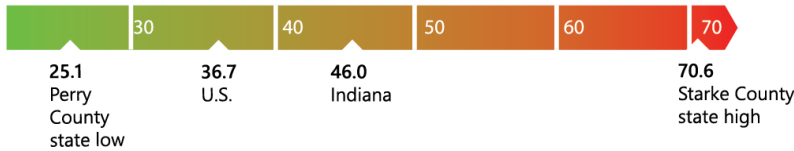

Tobacco and Health in Scott County

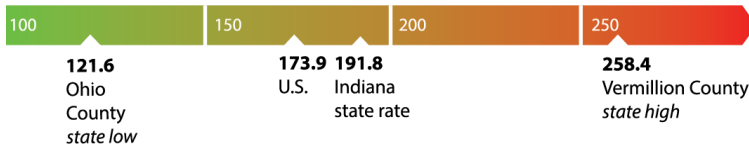
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **29.1%**



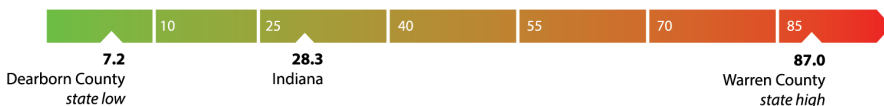
 **Lung cancer deaths** **60.9**
