

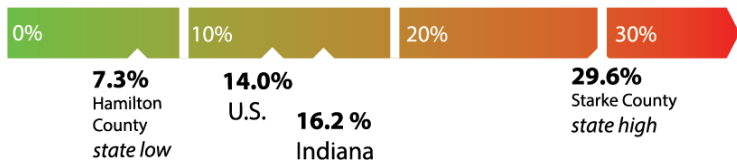

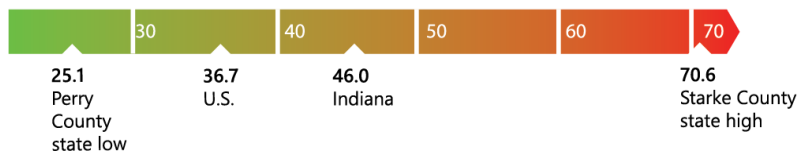

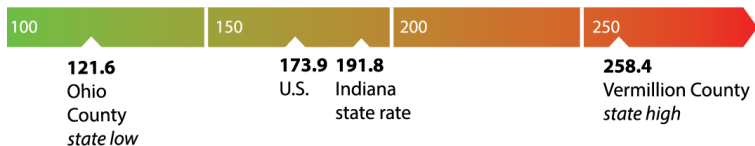
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.2%**



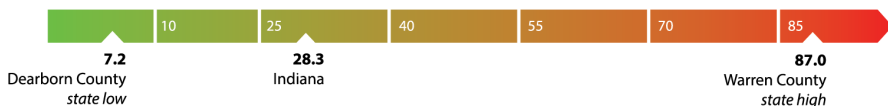
 **Lung cancer deaths** **54.6**
