

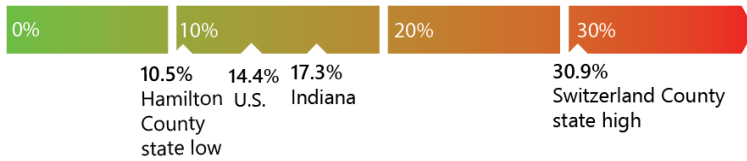

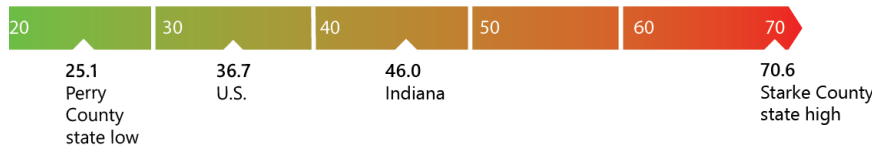

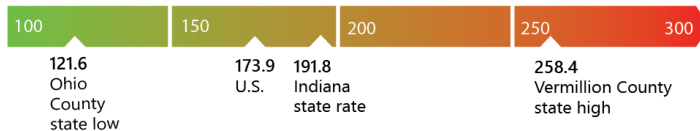
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **30.9%**



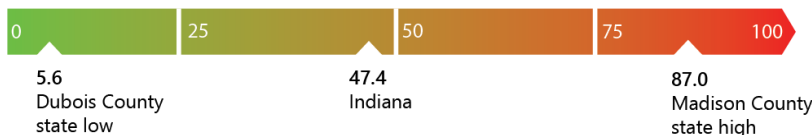
 **Lung cancer deaths**
