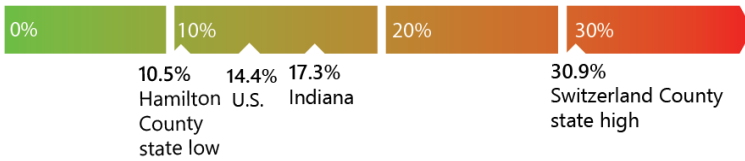

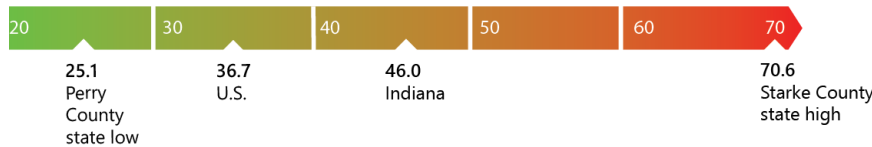
There is no tobacco control grant in Johnson County for 2023-2025.

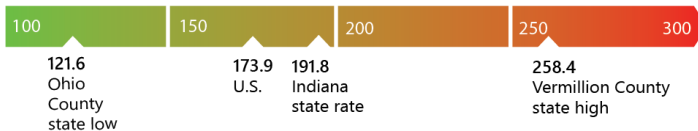
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **20.0%**



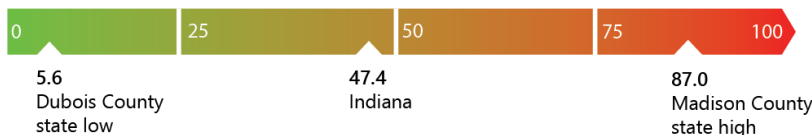
