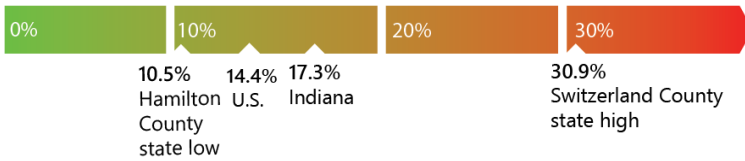

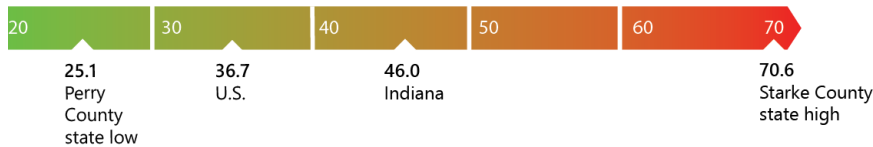
There is no tobacco control grant in LaGrange County for 2023-2025.

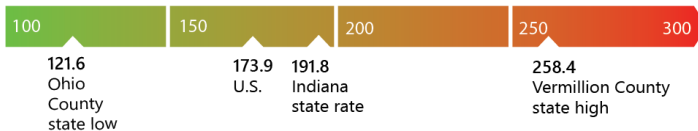
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.6%**



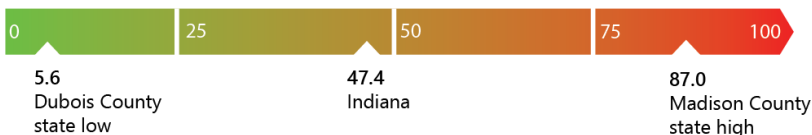
