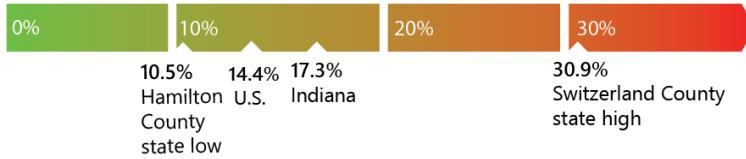

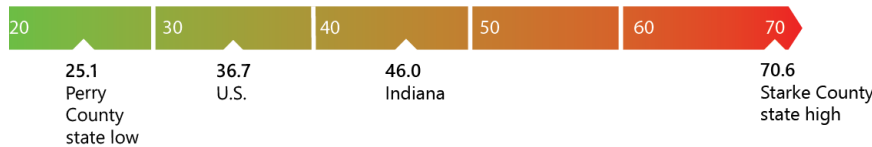
Percent of adults who smoke

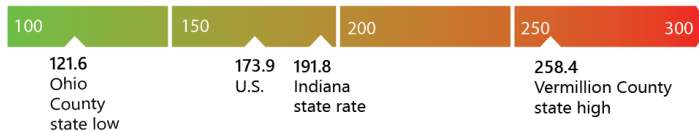
Lung cancer deaths

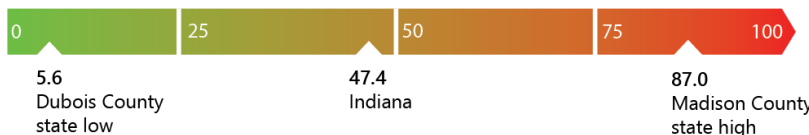
Heart disease deaths
