4. Trauma Network Design update – next meeting in November/early December?
  - a. Drs. Parikh and Kong, researchers, are working on trauma design optimization. They looked at data from Ohio trauma registry and utilized the NBATS tool and where the TCs were placed.
    - i. They identified that the # of TCs that the NBATS recommended was OK but the placement needed to be different.
    - ii. They are now going to try and work on expanding the model and are including Indiana data.

    - iii. Katie asked them to come to a spring meeting to share about their work.
