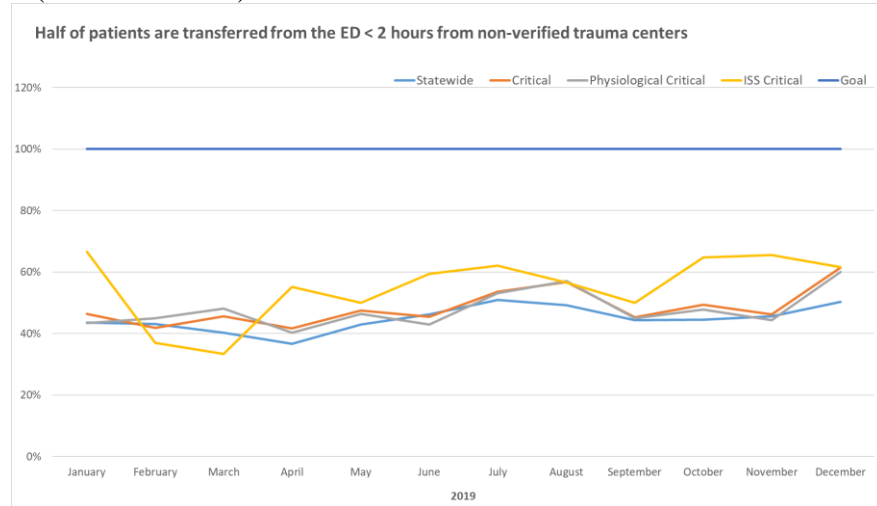

2. Dr. Kaufmann update

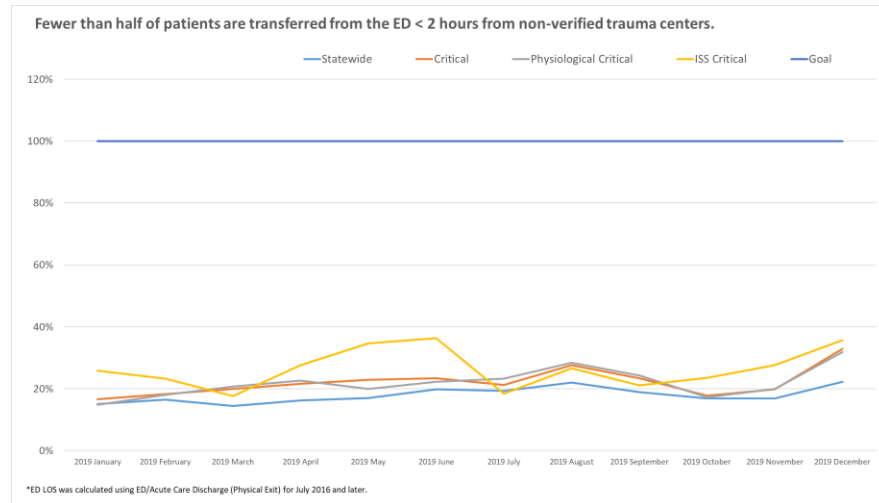
- a. IDHS is continuing to assist during the pandemic.
- b. Data analysis on penetrating and blunt injuries with penetration injuries is higher than blunt injuries.
- c. EMS run sheets – IDSH working with FSSA and IHI to file an application with CMS for funding and making progress on uploading EMS run sheets to CareWeb through IHI.

- d. IDHS scheduled EMS providers forum in each district
 - e. Interested to get feedback from providers on delays in EMS – specifically on rural areas.
3. 2020 Goals
- a. Decrease ED LOS at non-trauma centers
 - b. Increase trauma registry quiz participation
 - c. Collect hospital level variables – Dr. Jenkins deadline
 - d. Continued EMS run sheet collection
- Dr. Hammer will continue this goal for 2021. He also wants to have a discussion what need to be add to 2021 goals in the next meeting

4. Decrease ED LOS at non-trauma centers
- a. Letters to hospitals about ED discharge date/time
 - i. Quarter 4 2019: 14 letters were sent and 9 received by 09/15/2020
 - There are 11 hospitals with ED LOS > 11 hours and only 11 hospitals providing reasons for prolonged ED LOS.
 - b. There are 68 hospitals with ED LOS > 2 hours with a total of 350 incidents.

- Lisa Hollister requested IDH to provide year by year of ED LOS for 2015 to 2019 to review and evaluate in the next meeting for 2021 goals.
 - Lisa Hollister would also like to know any data quality issues happened in the registry as now they have established a registry committee that could work together to address and resolve those errors/issues.
5. Increase trauma registry quiz participation
 - a. May – 24, June - 24, July - 25, August -21
 - i. Result (for August 2020 quiz): 77% (was 76% last meeting)
 6. Collect hospital level variables
 - a. This request was approved at the February ISTCC meeting
 - i. 89 hospitals so far, September 30th deadline
- Ramzi push back the deadline to the end of this year but can be extend to next year if necessary.
 - Lisa – Is this about getting other hospitals onboard that did not submit data to the state?
 - o Dr. Jenkins – No. The trauma registry does not include critical information about hospital such as number of hospital bed, ICU, surgeon availability, etc.
 - Ramzi –moved the survey from SurveyMonkey to RedCap to capture the information better.
 - Dr. Jenkins – how are we going to follow up on this?
 - o Katie – suggest the survey to be send to each district and have the district leaders follow up with hospitals in the district.
 - o Dr. Hammer – Support this suggestion.

 - b. Who can reach out to non-reporting hospitals by district? What are the hospital's barriers to reporting?
 - i. Recommend that if someone in the district reaching out to the individual at any particular facility, please record the name and contact information and send back to Ramzi.
 - c. Transfer delay
 - i. Ramzi - there is difficulty of getting this variable fill as there are lack of resources, staffs, and missing information of reason of the delay in patient's record.
 - Suggest evaluating this for next year and make the variable more specific and easier to navigate.
 - ii. Dr. Jenkins – concern about asking NTCs to fill out additional fields as these hospitals commonly do not have enough resources and still require doing extra work.
 - Do not agree to add more field or variables for NTCs but instead work with them and resolve current issues instead.
 - Dr. Hammer – Agree!
 - iii. Dr. Hammer – suggest taking a step back on contact hospitals and getting the information for current issues before adding new fields to this matter.
