The Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology (DHPA) has reviewed the application to probe for grave memorials in the Hosier Cemetery (CR-90-46) within the State of Indiana in accordance with Indiana Code (IC) 14-21-1-26, Indiana Administrative Code 312 IAC 22-4. The plan is acceptable with the following conditions:

1. The methods for probing for grave memorials, Indiana Administrative Code 312 IAC 22-4 will be adhered to under this approved plan.
2. This license is non-transferable to another individual, nor to another cemetery.
3. This authorization does not apply to the locating of graves, human remains, or artifacts.
4. If human remains are encountered, the discovery must be treated in accordance with IC 14-21-1 and 312 IAC 22. In that event, please call (317) 232-1646.
5. This license is in effect through August 10, 2021. If you need an extension, please contact me before August 1, 2021.

With these conditions, the license for non-scientific probing in the Hosier Cemetery (CR-90-46) by Jerri Lehman is approved. A copy of this letter, along with proper identification, should be carried by you while working in the cemetery. This will ensure minimal confusion should they be requested by law enforcement personnel. If you have any questions regarding this authorization, please contact me at 317/234-1268.
