Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, February 25, 2018, marks the 239th anniversary of the 1779 surrender of Fort Sackville at Vincennes to George Rogers Clark by Henry Hamilton, British Lieutenant Governor of Detroit; and

WHEREAS, on this day, the citizens of Vincennes and the schools and citizens of Indiana are encouraged to commemorate George Rogers Clark for his great contributions to the cause of American independence and the establishment of Clarksville, the first permanent American settlement in the Northwest Territory; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Historical Bureau provides educational information about the life of George Rogers Clark and his contributions on its website in.gov/history, to assist in this commemoration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim the February 25th, 2018 as

GEORGE ROGERS CLARK DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
