For the year 2005-2006

1. Find and restore all stones in Bever Cemetery
2. Purchased new compressor for shop
3. Purchase new mower and 18' trailer
4. Start recording of all individual stones and mapping of each yard, 16 yards recorded as of 1/10/06.
5. Do more searching and clean up of Nicholas Reagan Cemetery in 2006 and find the rest of his stone. Also put stone wall back together.
6. Do more searching on the Gettinger Farm Cemetery. The oldest marked headstone in the county is there. It sets on the Old Cincinnati Trail. July 7, 1777 no name found yet

1. Kirkwood Cemetery, Posey Twp. Sec. 18
Fence repaired and repainted 3-4-05
2. Shawnee Bluff Cemetery, Posey Twp. Sec. 14
Trees down in this yard. Cleaned up and fence fixed in late March
4 new stones found 9-15-05
3. Brittnam Cemetery, Posey Twp. Sec. 2
Fence repaired and downed limbs cleaned up. In very good shape
4. Caldwell Cemetery, Harrison Twp. Sec 33
Family that owns this property said they were going to take over cleaning
of this yard.
5. Williams Cemetery, Harrison Twp. Sec. 6
This yard cleaned and weed eating done mid April. This yard hard to get
to, one quarter mile off road in woods. Do not have 4 wheel drive truck to
get to it.
6. Thomas Cemetery, Harrison Twp. Sec 4
This yard sets in the middle of a corn field, access to this yard in early
spring and late fall only. Cleaned weeds and limbs out in April, cement
enclosure needs to be repaired and trees taken down.
7. Dickey Cemetery, Harrison Twp. Sec. 8
Weeded, cleaned and fence fixed. Needs new gate. Weekly Maintenance
8. Campbell Cemetery, Harrison Twp. Sec. 7
Reset 2 stones knocked down by deer. Front of yard sets on County Road
550W. Needs to be shored up. Will check with County Engineer to see
what can be done to keep it from caving anymore.
9. Wiley Chapel Cemetery, Fairview Twp. Sec. 13
Tree down on west side of yard. Cleaned up and new walk in gate put up
in May

10. Martin Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 20
Over the course of 2005 I have found 5 new head stones sunken 6 inches deep or more, 11 foot stones tossed over East side of fence and 4 stones under fence row. Will clean and put in place as time and weather permits
11. Tate Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 35
Cut up downed trees, cleaned 3 new Craco family stones. Did not find bases for these stones, need to find out if I should put stones back up where they were found or not. This yard has been vandalized in the past. The fence in this yard needs to be replaced
12. Murray Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec 33
3 Stones in yard. We know the rest of the stones are in the field next to it, but cannot get farmers permission to search the field, will keep trying
13. Lockhart Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 34
This yard had an electric fence around it in 2003 to keep cattle out of it by farmer. Cannot get into this yard.
14. Tullis Chapel Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 14
This yard has had damage done by cattle several times in the past 10 years. John Walters has fixed these stones many times. Now the new bridge that was put up years ago is in danger. Cannot get mowers across it. Yard now has to be weed eated. Approx 100 stones in this yard, takes 2 days to do, used to take 2 hours to mow.
15. Halstead Cemetery, Columbia Twp. Sec. 8
This yard has 4 stones in it, 3 of which are Revolutionary Soldiers. Yard mowed once a week.
16. Old Friend Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 3
Found 2 new stones, reset and leveled. Reset and leveled 11 other stones. Yard in good shape.
17. Old Orange Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 15
Fixed rot iron fence damaged by car in 2004. Found 4 new stones, have not fixed yet. Yard is in good shape. Mowed and weed eated once a week.

18. Dawson & Merrick Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 14
2 Stones in Memorial fashion. New fence out in Spring 2003. Mowed Weekly
19. Bever Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 14
99% restored. This cemetery had been looked for for many years and was found by myself and the previous supervisor Darryll Morehead in the Fall of 2003. The Stephens family stones were found in 2003 and all the Bever family stones were found in the Spring of 2004. I started restoration on this yard on April 1, 2004 and finished April 1, 2005. Thanks to John Walters and Danny Farris for helping me and the other volunteers who help put this yard back together. It is now maintained weekly as it should be.
20. Sicas and Evans Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 22
New barbed wire fence put up to keep horses out of yard. Maintained bi-weekly.
21. Wright Family Plot, Orange Twp. Sec. 23
Grandparents of Wright Brothers. This yard sets back in a cornfield and is maintained bi-weekly. 2 stones knocked over by deer, will reset in Spring. This yard should have a fence put around it and the tomb fixed.
22. Coon Family Plot, Orange Twp. Sec. 27
This yard done weekly and in fair shape. Horses in field around yard, need to keep and eye on the fence.
23. Carpenter Farm Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 26
I recently received a phone call from Wilbur Steavens in Macon, MO, who told me that his great-great grandfather Robert Steavens and family are supposed to be buried there. I searched but did not locate the stones. It was reported that a farmer, years ago, used some of the stones as weight for his plow. Unfortunately this has happened a lot over the years. I will keep searching for more of the stones as time and weather permits.

24. Klum Cemetery, Columbia Twp. Sec. 29
This yard sets back in hayfield approx. 200 yards. Hard to get to when wet, as we don't have a 4x4 truck. This yard was maintained bi-weekly this year, 2005. I had no help from Probation office this year and was on my own most of the Spring. Yard needs weekly care, but is in fair shape.
25. Ronald Gray Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 12
I built a new picket fence over Winter of 2004 and put it up in Spring 2005. I'm building an arbor with a bench beside the yard. Found new stones 8-10-04 Ruth E. daughter of John & Martha Ronald. Also foot stone for Robert Gray
26. Kinney Farm Cemetery, Orange Twp. Sec. 14
10-21-05 Stone wall on West side of yard knocked down by cattle. Yard was entered but nothing hurt by cows. Put wall & gate back up. Yard needs barbed wire fence around it. Will do this as soon as possible.
27. Nulltown Cemetery, Columbia Twp. Sec. 14
This yard is taken care of once a week, it needs a new fence that I will do as time & money presents itself. Since John Walters restored this yard in 2000, we have found 8 new stones with writing and 45 new field stones, all but 10 have been raised and reset.
28. Webb Cemetery, Columbia Twp. Sec. 22
Until this year, yard was very hard to get to. This year Mike Hudson who owns the property around it built a new road to make it easier to access. Previously there were 122 headstones, footstones & fieldstones accounted for. I now have 170 stones. I have not yet mapped this yard, but I will. I have 16 cemeteries mapped so far, more to come.

29. Green Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 23
I'm working on restoring this yard. The DAR records show nine Headstones & one marker for Thomas Green to be in this yard. So far I have found three of these stones, Daniel Green, infant son of Daniel & Nancy Green & Betsy Steele, wife of Asbury Steele. Also I have Nancy Green, wife of Daniel Green & Washington, son of Daniel & Nancy Green. These two stones were not in the records. I'll keep working until I find the rest of them and put the yard back together.
30. Brumfield cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 13
This yard is maintained weekly and is in fairly good shape. I need to clean and reset a few stones. Yard is hard to get into in the Spring. It sets on top of a hill, 200 yards off the road.
31. Mt. Zion Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 13
This is a very large yard and hard to keep up. There were 49 stones vandalized in the Fall of 2004. John Walters helped me get 18 stones back up before the end of the year. I did not get to work on anymore stones during 2005. I had all the other yards to mow & take care of. One person cannot raise these stones, some 9 & 10 feet tall. By yourself it's just too dangerous. When I get some help, I will get the rest put back up. I need 1 full-time and 1 part-time helper.
32. Union Chapel Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 12
This yard has 6 stones that need to be fixed & reset. Yard is maintained weekly and is in good shape except for limbs that need to be burned.
33. Mt. Garrison Cemetery, Jennings Twp. Sec. 15
This cemetery is in fair shape. One stone that needs fixed is Amos Milner, Revolutionary War. It is very delicate. I will enlist John Walters help on this one. We need to get with highway dept. about snow plows in Winter getting too close to cemetery.
34. Hanson a/k/a Crandel Cemetery, Jennings Twp. Sec. 11
Set up as a memorial years ago. The cemetery sat in the middle of a cornfield, Have not found any new stones but will keep looking.

35. Burk Cemetery, Jennings Twp. Sec. 34
This yard sets one quarter mile back in field. You have to cross a creek To get to this yard. During Spring rains you cannot get to this yard. I Cleaned this yard several times this year, reset 5 stones, found 4 more. Trying to match up footstones thrown over the fence & put them back where they belong. Need better access to this yard so it can be done on weekly route, so it doesn't get out of hand.
36. Simpson Cemetery, Jennings Twp. Sec. 23
This yard is in fair shape, done weekly. I have found some footstones discarded years ago. I will put back in place. Still removing several tree stumps in this yard.
37. Strong Family Plot, Waterloo Twp. Sec. 14
One obelisk stone in center of yard & 8 field stones to the south of it is all that is in this yard. Taken care of bi-weekly weed eaten only.
38. Holland Plot, Waterloo Twp. Sec. 2
One stone, unreadable, and one fieldstone yard found May 1, 2003
Weed eat bi-weekly
39. Sudcliff, Waterloo Twp. Sec. 15
I have not yet been to this cemetery. It is very hard to get to and can be visited only in the Spring & Fall because of crops. Will try to get it this year 2006.
40. Robinson Chapel, Waterloo Twp. Sec. 2
Very large yard, approx. 225 graves. There are some stones missing. Each year we probe this yard we find new stones at south side of the yard. I had four large limbs removed this year that were endangering several large monuments at the cost of \$650.00, well worth the price. Yard is done once a week, approx. 3 hours to do. This is one of the larger yards we have.

41. Waterloo Cemetery, Waterloo Twp. Sec. 32
This yard sets back one-eighth mile off the road. John Walters restored this yard in Oct 1997. Since I started as Supervisor in March 2004 I have found 4 new headstones several original bases and 5 footstones. One headstone is that of Daniel T Sampson of 47th Reg Cob Ind Volunteers. This name was not on the wall of honor in the courthouse. Several stones are again broke from freeze & thaw weather. I will fix them and keep searching for more.
42. Popular Ridge Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 23
At the time Mrs. Louis A. Brown, John Connor Chapter of the DAR, recorded only 3 readable stones. There are now 5 readable headstones, 7 footstones & 116 fieldstones or 58 graves marked by fieldstones. I have talked to Odell Callihan, the property owner, he told me he's going to put in a new set of steps & a bench. He cares for the cemetery & what happens to it. We clean this yard bi-weekly and he cleans it when he gets time. I will search for more stones.
43. Old Parrott Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 33
Cemetery sets back in a corn & bean field. Normally done only twice a year, Spring & Fall. Farmer gave us permission to drive over crops if we wanted to. I intend to do that in 2006 so the yard doesn't get over grown. I will put on bi-weekly route.
44. Old Waters Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 33
This yard is very hard to access when wet. Sets a quarter mile off the road. I have found a few new stones and bases this year. I know there are more to be found. I will search more as time permits. Yard is done bi-weekly. Needs new fence.
45. Grist Cemetery, Jackson Twp. Sec. 35
I know the cemetery is here according to records, but so far have not Been able to find it. I will keep searching.

46. Nicholas Reagan Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 2
In this yard so far I can tell was a tomb for Nicholas Reagan and his wife. I have found the half of the stone with information on Nicholas, 3 foot deep, but so far have not been able to find the rest of this stone. The block wall around it needs to be put back together and I will need a lot of help with this one. Their very large stones. Sets in the middle of a cornfield.
47. Casady Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 32
Where the stones are set up now was believed to be just a small cemetery. As of 2005, I found out cemetery consists of at least one acre. I found several new stones across the fence and property lines. Several stones under trees I cannot move myself. A lot of building going on not far from it. Needs to be searched extensively and surveyed and plotted.
48. Parker Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 25
Cemetery set on hill behind Elmhurst Lodge. Take care of bi-weekly. Stones need cleaned and reset, fence needs to be put around it.
49. Smith Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 35
Here are 3 stones left in this yard, encased in cement. Cannot get in this yard anymore. The new owners put electric fence surrounding the field it sets in for his horses.
50. Minor Cemetery, Connersville Twp. Sec. 35
This cemetery sits behind County Highway Dept.. Stones are lying down, encased in cement. Yard hard to get to. Long walk uphill and through brush. Taken care of once a month, weed eat only.

This is not a complete list of all the cemeteries in Fayette County, but it does give you an idea of things being done and things that need to be accomplished. As of 5/20/98, there were 53 known Veterans in these cemeteries. As of now, 1/13/06, we have 98. 1/10/05, I started measuring, recording and drawing of each stone in every yard we have in Fayette County. As of 1/10/06, I have finished 16 yards. All have been copied for Connersville Library. I hope to finish 4 more complete cemeteries by Spring, when mowing season begins.

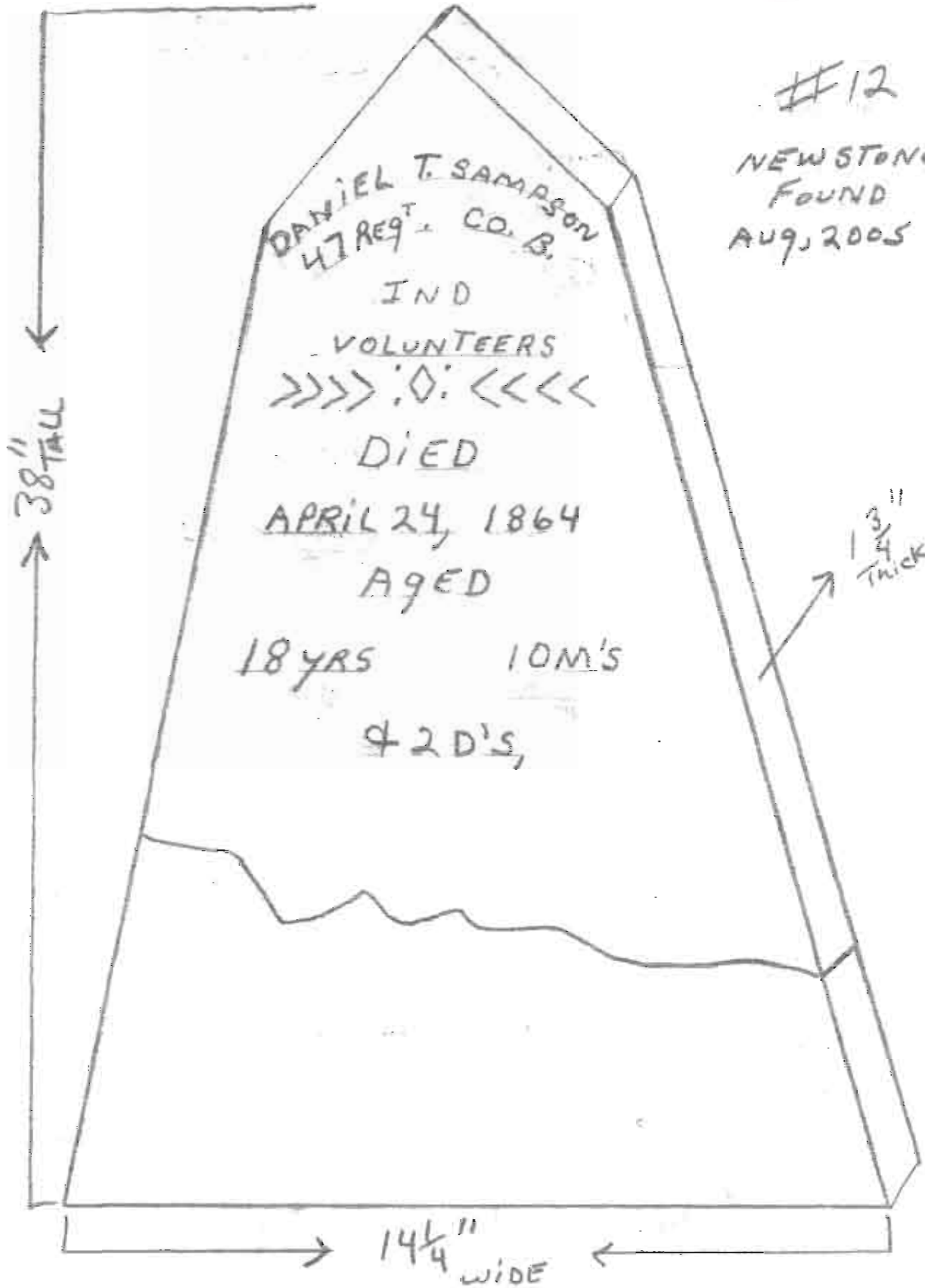

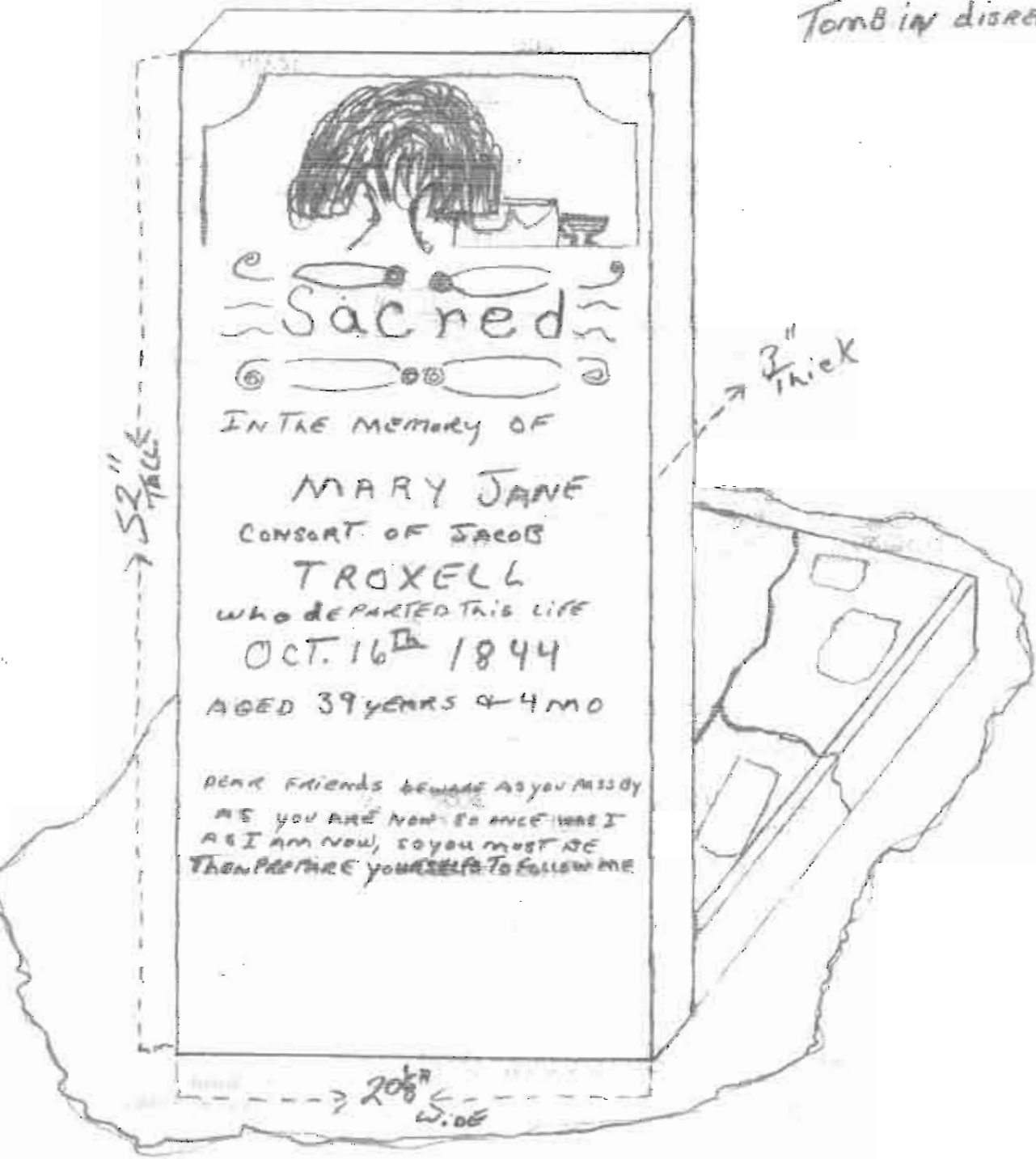
