Dear Standardbred Owner:

The year 2013 was a record breaking year for the Standardbred industry in Indiana. During the course of the racing season, multiple records were broken at Hoosier Park, many of them by Indiana Sired horses. The quality of Indiana Sired horses continues to improve resulting in outstanding accomplishments not only in Indiana, but also nationally. I predict we will continue to see these types of successes during 2014.

You will find the 2014 program outlined in detail in this booklet; however I would like to highlight a few items that you should be aware of:

- The Indiana Sires Stakes format has been changed for 2014. This new and improved format will feature five eliminations, and from each elimination, the top twenty (20) horses will return to compete in a final and consolation. The top ten (10) horses from the finals will return to compete in a super final.
- Be aware of the number of days needed between racing in a pari-mutual race and an Indiana Sired Fair Circuit race (going from race track to fair). The chart below clarifies the days required between these starts. It is also found in the Indiana Sired Fair Circuit conditions on page 28.

- The eligibility requirements for Series 2 of the Indiana Sired Fair Circuit are as follows:
 - Two Year Olds - NW \$20,000 in 2014 up to and including 8/31/14
 - Three Year Olds - NW \$20,000 in 2014 up to and including 8/31/14
- We are happy to welcome the Delaware County Fair (Muncie) to the 2014 ISFC schedule.
- You will find a W-9 form on page 39 of this booklet. Many of the fairs are requiring that these be completed and submitted prior to receiving any purse money from that fair. Please copy this form and make sure you have one to submit at each fair. Please note, that if a fair requires this, they will not release the purse check until they receive the completed W-9 form.

Additional information you will find detailed in this booklet includes race conditions, nomination deadlines and payment addresses for various races. Please pay close attention to all of those items when nominating your horses. If you need additional nomination forms, you may download them from our website at www.in.gov/hrc.

Mini-Series Rules

Hoosier Park will have a variety of Mini-Series during the 2014 race meet for Indiana Sired horses. These series will appear on the overnight sheet and do not require a nomination or starting fee. For more information, please contact Jessica Barnes at (317) 233-3119 or the Race Secretary at Hoosier Park.

- 1. Nominations:** There are no nomination or starting fees required.
- 2. Race Conditions:**
 1. All horses must meet host track qualifying standards in order to be eligible to compete in Mini-Series.
 2. To be raced as an elimination(s) and a final.
 3. No trainer or owner may race more than two (2) horses per division in a Mini-Series, elimination or final.
 4. If there are thirteen (13) or fewer entries, twelve (12) starters will be determined by preference date, and also eligibles will be drawn. If there are fourteen (14) or more eligible entries the race will be split into divisions.
 5. Eliminations or finals will only take place if there are eight (8) or more betting interests, and may take place with seven (7) at the track's discretion.
 6. Horses with the highest point earnings from the elimination(s) who declare into the box will compete in the final. To be eligible for the final, a horse must have started in an elimination. The final will be limited to ten (10) horses. If there is a tie for tenth (10th) place, entry will be drawn by lot. Two (2) also eligibles for the final may be selected from the next two (2) highest point earners. If there are eight (8) or more additional eligible entries, a consolation for the next group of top point earners may be held at the discretion of the race secretary at elimination purse levels.
 7. No owner and/or trainer will be permitted to race two (2) horses in a Mini-Series to the exclusion of a single entry.
- 3. Claiming Mini-Series:**
 1. Horses may be claimed out of the elimination races or the final of these series.
 2. Claiming Allowances: 2 yr olds – 100%, 3 yr olds – 50%, 4 yr olds – 25%, Mares – 20%
- 4. Conditioned Mini-Series:** Horses which are eligible prior to the elimination of a series will remain eligible for final, regardless of their winnings after the elimination race.

**2014 Standardbred Breed Development Policy on
Indiana Bred Bonus and Breeder's Award Payments**

Indiana Bred (IB) Bonus

Indiana Bred Bonus (IB): An award paid to any Indiana Bred horse competing in open company (a race not restricted to Indiana Bred Horses) at Hoosier Park that finishes first. Please note that the race must be classified as \$8000 Claiming (Base Claiming Price) or above. The award will be paid to the owner of the Indiana Bred horse based on percentage win earnings of the total win earnings available.

Indiana bred horses are defined as follows:

***For Foals of 2010 - 2013:** A foal bred to a Stallion not registered in Indiana and from a mare which was registered & resided in the State of Indiana continuously from June 1st for foals of 2010 and 2011, and August 1st for foals of 2012 and beyond of the breeding year through the time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the IHRC.

***For Foals of 2009 and prior:** Breeders are as registered by the USTA. Any and all breeders of the horse must be Indiana residents. Any partnership or corporation registered by the USTA as breeder must be totally composed of Indiana residents.

Owner Defined: For the purpose of the IB Bonus Award, the owner is defined as the individual whose name appears as owner on the official judges sheet for the race in question (*Unless the owner is listed incorrectly*). If the award is to be paid to a stable name/business then the registered owner must be listed as that stable name/business. In the case of leased horses, if the lessee is listed as the official owner on the judges sheet, the IB Bonus will be paid to the lessee. ***If there are multiple owners/lessees listed, the award will be paid to the first individual listed with the USTA. It is that individual's responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed owners/lessees.***

Amount of IB Bonus: The Bonus is paid to the owner/lessee of the Indiana Bred horse through using the following formula:

$$\text{Owner's Bonus Amt} = \% \text{ of win earnings in eligible races} * \text{Amt Available } (\$25,000)$$

Please note: Bonuses will be paid on an annual basis at the completion of the last race meet in Indiana. Bonuses are paid by the Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack.

Indiana Sired & Bred Breeder Awards

Indiana Sired & Bred (ISB):

***For Foals of 2010 & beyond:** A foal sired by a registered Indiana Stallion and from a mare which was registered & resided in the State of Indiana continuously from June 1st for foals of 2010 and 2011, and August 1st for foals of 2012 and beyond of the breeding year through the time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the IHRC.

***For Foals of 2009 & prior:** A foal sired by a stallion standing in Indiana and registered with the IHRC the year the foal was conceived.

Breeder Award: An award paid to the registered breeder of the Indiana Sired & Bred horse (**excluding any horse that has raced for a claiming price tag**) through using the following formula:

$$\text{Breeder's Awd Amt} = \% \text{ of win earnings in eligible races} * \text{Amt of available } (\$700,000)$$

Breeder Defined: The breeder is the individual listed on the horse's registration papers as the breeder by the USTA. If the award is to be paid to a stable name/business then the registered owner must be listed as that stable name/business. ***If there are multiple breeders listed, the award will be paid to the individual listed first. It is the individual who receives the awards responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed breeders.***

Who is Eligible for a Breeder's Award?: The horse must win an eligible race and **NOT raced for a claiming price tag** to be eligible to the Breeder's Award Pool. The criteria is as follows:

- Two Year Olds & Three Year Olds - Indiana Sired & Bred (ISB) Horses only that win any race at the Pari-Mutual Tracks in Indiana or ISFC Championship Races.
- Aged Horses - Four Year Old Indiana Sired & Bred (ISB) and Five Year Old & Older Indiana Sired (IS) that win:
 - *Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
 - *Elimination or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
 - *Track's Open or Invitational Race

Please Note: Breeder's Awards will be paid on an annual basis, at the completion of the race meet in Indiana. Breeder's Awards are paid by the Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack, and the award is not added to the horse's earnings.

Please Note: In order to receive an award, you must have a completed W-9 & Direct Deposit Form on file with the State of Indiana.

INDIANA SIRES STAKES

General Conditions for 2014; Two & Three Year Old Divisions

Sponsor: Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board (Board)
For: Foals of 2012 and 2011 sired by stallions registered in the Indiana Stallion Registry the year the foals were conceived.
To be Raced As: Five (5) legs consisting of an Elimination, Leg Final and Leg Consolation, and One (1) Super Final for Two (2) and Three (3) year old Trotters and Pacers in 2014.
To be Raced At: Hoosier Park in eliminations, finals, consolations and Super Final as scheduled.
Payments: (U.S. Funds) One (1) nomination payment will allow a horse to be eligible excluding the Aged divisions.

Two year olds in 2014-
 April 15, 2014.....\$ 500.00
 Elimination - Entry Fee (Payable to Hoosier Park) per leg.....\$ 500.00
 Three year olds in 2014-
 March 15, 2014..... \$ 500.00
 Elimination - Entry Fee (Payable to Hoosier Park) per leg..... \$ 500.00

Once a horse is drawn into the elimination, the entry fee is due, even if the horse is scratched prior to the race. *Please Note: There will not be an entry fee required for the final, consolation or super final.*

Declaration: Starters are to declare in at the regular time practiced at Hoosier Park. All declarations are subject to Indiana Horse Racing Commission Rules.

The following time requirements must have been met at the time of declaration:

2 Year Old	3 Year Old
Pace..... 1:58	Pace.....1:56
Trot..... 2:03	Trot.....2:01

An allowance of two (2) seconds will be allowed for pari-mutuel tracks that are less than 7/8th of a mile. An allowance of three (3) seconds will be allowed for any fair half-mile track, *no additional allowances will be given, unless given by the Judges at the ISS host track.* All horses must have a clean line within the last thirty (30) days from race date to race date and not be on the judges list at time of entry unless declared ineligible under 71 IAC 3-2-9(g) or 71 IAC 3-2-9(h).

Entry Fee: To be paid at the Office of the Director of Racing at the host track at least one (1) hour prior to post time.

Money Division: Purses for races will be divided 50-25-12-8-5 percent.

Race Conditions: Each event is to be raced one (1) heat at one (1) mile each.

If more than twelve (12) horses declare to start, the leg will be split into divisions according to the attached chart.

All finals will be raced. All eliminations will be contested, regardless of the number of entries. All drug testing samples, taken from horses competing in the Indiana Sires Stakes, may be frozen for future testing.

The top ten (10) horses from the elimination who declare into the box will compete in that leg final. If there is a tie for tenth (10th) place, entry will be drawn by lot. After the leg final is determined, the next ten (10) horses from the elimination who declare into the box will compete in the leg consolation. If there is a tie for tenth (10th) place, entry will be drawn by lot. All post positions will be drawn.

Points will be awarded in each leg final as follows:

1st 50 points	4th 8 points
2nd 25 points	5th 5 points
3rd 12 points	

All starters will receive one (1) point for each leg final raced. The top ten (10) point earning horses from the leg finals who declare in the box will compete in the super final. If there is a tie for tenth (10th) place, entry will be drawn by lot. Two (2) also eligibles will be drawn. A horse must have started in at least one (1) leg final in order to be eligible for the super final.

Purses: Eliminations with eight (8) or more betting interests may be raced as non-pari-mutuel event at the discretion of the race secretary. If there are fewer than eight (8) betting interests, the race may be raced as a pari-mutuel race for the full advertised purse at the discretion of the race secretary.

Purses for eliminations with eleven (11) or more starters will be increased by twenty percent (20%).

In eliminations with a field of eleven (11) or more starters, the sixth (6th) place finisher will receive three percent (3%) and the seventh (7th) place finisher will receive two percent (2%) of the purse. The purse payout will be distributed as follows:

1st Place \$11,400	5th Place \$1,140
2nd Place \$5,700	6th Place \$720
3rd Place \$2,736	7th Place \$480
4th Place \$1,824	

Each 6th – 10th place finisher in the Super Final shall receive \$4,000.

Emergency: If for any reason, including but not limited to, weather, it becomes impossible to race any of the events at the Host Track, it is at the discretion of the Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board (Board) to contest any of these races at a different time and place so designated by the Board. 

3. Purses for all races will be divided 50-25-12-8-5%.
4. Nominations close on the dates posted in the nomination book and must be postmarked on the dates posted on the condition book. Payment for nomination fees must be in U.S. Funds and made payable to Indiana Standardbred Breed Development.
5. Declarations close at the time and date posted on the condition sheet.
6. Horses must have raced in one leg in order to qualify for the final.
7. Ten (10) horses with the highest money earnings in the series will compete in the finals. If horses from the top ten (10) fail to declare in the finals, the next highest money earners who declare in will be eligible. All ties will be drawn by lot. Sponsor: Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board (Board)
For: Fair races for Indiana Sired and Bred (ISB) foals of 2011 and 2012, as defined by 71 IAC 14-1-3. Championship races at the Indiana State Fair to be held for foals of 2011 and foals of 2012.
To Be Raced As: One level for 2 and 3 Year Old Trotters and Pacers in 2014. Also to be raced as a Championship and Consolation race at the Indiana State Fair for 2 and 3 year old Trotters and Pacers in 2014 based on points earned in the Fair Circuit. A second series of races following the Indiana State Fair with a Championship based on points earned in this series. In order to be eligible for Series 2, the following eligibility requirements must be met:

Two Year Olds - NW \$20,000 in 2014 up to and including 8/31/14
 Three Year Olds - NW \$20,000 in 2014 up to and including 8/31/14

To Be Raced At: Locations to be designated annually by the Sponsor.

Nominations: **Two Year Olds:** April 15, 2014 - \$300
Three Year Olds: March 15, 2014 - \$300

Future Payments: No sustaining fees due.
Entry Fees: (Payable to Host Track)

Once a horse is drawn into a ISFC event, the entry fee is due, even if the horse is scratched. If entry fee is not paid, the horse will be ineligible to start in all subsequent fairs.

Entry Fee.....\$50.00

Please Note: *There will be no entry fee required for the Championship or Consolation race, but horses must check in at the race office one hour prior to the post time for the 1st race.*

Future Eligibility: If the two year old nominating payment is not made, an eligible foal may be nominated as a three year old or older.

Entry Fee: To be paid at the office of the director of racing at each host track prior to the start of the races.

Money Division: Purses will be paid 50-25-12-8-5 percent.

Race Conditions: Each two-year-old event is to be raced one heat at one mile each. Each three year old event will be raced either one or two heats at the option of the host track. There are no eliminations. The event may be raced in divisions, according to USTA rules with the following exceptions:

- If there is a minimum of five (5) fillies and five (5) colts in the specified level, the race will be split into divisions based on sex. If the minimum of five (5) entries is not met, the race will not be contested.
- If the minimum of five (5) fillies and/or five (5) colts is not met, all entries for that level will be in division(s) to be drawn at lot, with fillies drawing the inside post positions.
- No horse may compete in any ISFC event who has raced in any other race on the day of, or on any two (2) days prior to the event (qualifiers and rained-out ISFC events excluded).
- No horse may compete in any ISFC event who has raced in a Pari-Mutuel event on the day of or five (5) days prior to the event. For Example (see chart to the left):

Emergency: If for any reason, including but not limited to, weather, it becomes impossible to race any of the events at the host site, it is at the discretion of the Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board (Board) to contest any of these races at a different time and place so designated by the Board. The Board reserves the right to call off the event, and return to the entrants their pro-rated share of the accumulated horsemen portion of the purse, after deducting the clerical and administrative expenses allowed in these conditions. All entrants must abide by this change or forfeit their right to participate in these races or race for any part of the purse. In all circumstances, the Board will make the final decision.

Gait: Horses changing gait may be transferred to their adopted gait but payments made prior to that time will not be transferred.

Rules: Rules of the United States Trotting Association shall govern unless otherwise specified in these conditions or under the rules and regulations of the Board.

Championship Races: There will be Championship and Consolation races held for Series 1. The purse for the Championship race will be \$20,000 and the Consolation will be \$8,000. Of those that have declared to race at the Indiana State Fair (Series 1), the top eight (8) point earners that have participated in (or credited with) at least seven (7) Indiana Sired Fair Circuit races will be selected as starters for the Championship race and the next eight (8) point earners that have participated in (or credited with) at least seven (7) Indiana Sired Fair Circuit races will be selected as starters for the Consolation race. The Championship will be limited to eight (8) horses. When two (2) or more horses are tied for eighth (8th) place, then one horse from those tied will be drawn at lot to fill a Championship race. The Consolation will also be limited to eight (8) horses. When two or more horses are tied for eighth (8th) place, then one horse from those tied will be drawn by lot to fill the Consolation. **The Consolation must have a minimum of five (5) entries to take place.** There will be no combining of sexes in Consolation races. There will be a Championship race held for Series 2. The Championship for Series 2 will be contested at \$10,000. Horses competing in the Championship race held for Series 2 must have participated in (or credited with) at least three (3) starts in Series 2 and starters will be selected in the same manner as defined for Series 1 Championship.





Definitions & Requirements for Foals

Indiana Sired & Bred (ISB): A foal sired by a registered Indiana stallion and from a mare which resides in the State of Indiana continuously from August 1st of the breeding season year through the time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the IHRC.

-An ISB Foal must be sired by a registered stallion and foaled in the State of Indiana.

-An ISB Foal does not have to be owned by a resident of Indiana.

Indiana Sired (IS): A foal sired by a stallion standing in Indiana and registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission the year the foal was conceived.

-The mare of an IS foal does not have to reside in the State of Indiana and can be bred by shipped semen.

-An IS foal does not have to be foaled in the State of Indiana.

-An IS foal does not have to be owned by a resident of Indiana.

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General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.

The person who gives Form W-9 to the partnership for purposes of establishing its U.S. status and avoiding withholding on its allocable share of net income from the partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States is in the following cases:
