ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 4 - Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 3 LUCKY JADE (Marcus Miller) for possible violation of the breaking rule after the start. After reviewing video the judges determined that driver Miller complied with all aspects of the breaking rule and that furthermore no extended break occurred. Horse placed as finished.

Race 5 - Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 6 SWAN IN ALL (Jordan Ross) for possible violation of the breaking rule in the first turn (before and after the quarter). After reviewing video the judges determined that driver Ross complied with all aspects of the breaking rule and that furthermore no extended break occurred. Horse placed as finished.

Race 7 - No. 3 PRECIATE YALL (Atlee Bender) originally finished sixth placed eighth for a pylon violation in mid-stretch. The horse was inside three consecutive pylons and in so doing gained an unfair advantage over the seventh and eighth place horses. No penalty to driver Bender as the horse was out of the money.
