




Race 4 – Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 2 TIMBER MAN (Marcus Miller) for possible pylon violation in the stretch. After reviewing video, the judges determined that the horse was inside one pylon. No reason for placing.

Race 9 – Recall charged to No. 4 FLOUZZY for interference to No. 3 RACING ARTIST while on a break behind the gate.

Race 13 – Inquiries posted on unofficial third place and fourth place finishers No. 5 SHOOTING IN PLACE (Brandon Bates) and No. 2 BIKINI CHASER (Joey Putnam) for possible pylon violation in the first turn before the quarter. After reviewing video and taking calls from both Mr. Bates and Mr. Putnam the judges determined that the drivers were not interfered with by No. 8 PREMIER ROMEO (Atlee Bender) and therefore did commit pylon violations with each going inside multiple pylons in the first turn. For pylon violations No. 5 SHOOTING IN PLACE finished third placed seventh. No. 4 BIKINI CHASER finished fourth placed eighth. Penalties to both drivers were not issued due to the track condition and the rainy weather.
