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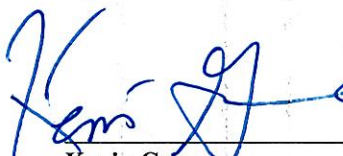

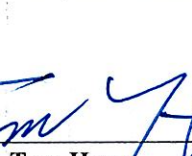

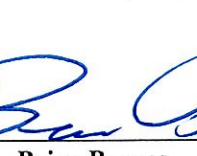
ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 4 – No. 6 HITEMWHERE THEY AINT was scratched by the judges. The horse's tattoo number was off a digit and the horse's markings did not match the description. The USTA sent their ID technician over to collect blood and hair samples for DNA matching.

Race 12 – Jack Griffith, driver of No. 10 ROCKIN DAWG, spoken to by the judges after his first career drive in which he ran up on 3 separate horses/drivers during the mile. To his credit, Mr. Griffith realized that his first drive did not go very well.
