Norton ~~where did he say~~ What did he say to you he told me he assisted in turning a corpse from the Cemetery in Terre Haute he said they put it in a spring wagon and ~~came away with it~~ took it home. did he tell who was with him. yes. who did he say it was. Dr. Morgan was one Emmett Shepard was the driver I do not know what he had to do with it. who was ~~or~~ the other one I do not know which one of two it was was it in Terre Haute he told you they got both subjects. no. he said one was at this side of the River. did they tell you where ~~did~~ they got the first subject. no. Who were the other other two parties.
