Descriptive volumes arranged numerically by post number, from Post sixteen (16) to Post five hundred eighty-nine (589). The descriptive volumes of some posts do not survive. The surviving volumes in this series usually yield the following information about G.A.R. members: name, age, birthplace, residence, occupation, service dates, company and regiment, length of service, cause of discharge from service, date of muster into G.A.R. and whether honorably discharged, suspended, dropped, or dismissed, nature of war wounds received and name of battle or battles where wounds occurred, and remarks. Dates of death as late as the 1930's often appear in the remarks section.

Unbound documents, such as post muster rolls, lists of post officers, membership transfer cards, or printed circulars are occasionally found in the volumes. Original post charters are contained in the volumes for Posts 19 and 135. Records from Post 267 contain a list of dead soldiers from Liberty Township, Delaware County, with places of burial. The volume for Post 115 includes a cemetery list. The Post 333 volume includes a description of the funeral rites of G.A.R. members. The volume for Post 89 contains a blank resolution of respect form that was sent to families of deceased members.
