<sup>2</sup> The attorney general has 45 days from the date an agency submits or resubmits a rule. To note, this agency is not usually notified when the attorney general forwards the rule amendment package to the governor. IC 4-22-2-32.

<sup>3</sup> The governor may approve or disapprove a rule with or without cause. The governor has 15 days from the date of rule submittal to approve or disapprove the rule. However, the governor may take 30 days to approve or disapprove the rule if the governor files a statement with the publisher within the first 15 days after rule submittal that states the governor intends to take an additional 15 days to approve or disapprove the rule. IC 4-22-2-34. [To note, this agency is not customarily notified of the date the rule package is submitted to the Governor's Office.].

<sup>4</sup> Rule becomes effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher (unless a later effective date is specified in the rule). IC 4-22-2-36.
