In the summer of 2016, I joined the staff of Emma Donnan Elementary and Middle School as a curriculum resource teacher. To gain more context on our work as a turnaround school, I read Matthew Tully's Searching for Hope: Life at a Failing School in the Heart of America. It depicted the state of Emmerich Manual High School under IPS. While Tully painted a few bright spots, it mostly described a school with insurmountable challenges—ones that IPS could not fix. His conclusion was that the only way for such a failing school to be revived was to try something new.

Thankfully for students and families in the Garfield Park neighborhood, the state of Indiana gave Manual High a fresh start under new management. Since the turnaround, I sincerely believe that Emma Donnan Elementary (established in 2015), Emma Donnan Middle School, TC Howe Community High School, and Emmerich Manual High School are all better schools than they were under IPS.

In my first year at Emma Donnan, I was part of the academic team that helped the elementary school achieve an "A" rating. After reorganizing some critical systems, we led the middle school to a "C" state report card grade. It was the first time that middle school had received any grade other than an "F" since accountability began. Our colleagues at Howe have done amazing work with their school culture and graduation rates. Manual High has achieved a "C" rating from the state each of the last several years. These schools are in a much different place since the turnaround.

As my first year as an assistant principal at Emmerich Manual High School, I firmly believe that we have a school that the south side of Indianapolis can be proud of. Our culture team works daily to create a safe and respectful environment. In my work focusing on academics, I am confident that we are preparing our young men and women to be successful beyond high school. Our teachers work collaboratively in professional learning communities to build rigorous assessments, analyze data, and spiral review. Our Success block allows students the gain needed remediation or extend their leaning. Our pathways allow students select avenues that will prepare them for the futures of their choice. I routinely spend time in classrooms observing instruction, and I am frequently amazed by the passion of our instructors and the potential of our students.


I am a 1958 graduate of Manual High School and I appeal to you to make sure that the school stays open to educate the students who are currently enrolled and will be enrolled in the future.


