

Meeting Minutes Indiana Commission on the Social Status of Black Males Government Center South Conference Room 5 302 W. Washington Street Indianapolis, IN 46204 Wednesday, January 17, 2024

Call to Order: A meeting of the Indiana Commission for the Social Status of Black Males (ICSSBM) was held on Wednesday, January 17, 2024, in person at the Government South Building Conference Room 5, and virtually via WebEx. The meeting was called to order at 10:46am.

Chair's Report: A quorum was not established for the January 2024, Commission meeting and no official business was discussed. Chair Jones informed everyone regarding the Commission's purpose and five-areas of focus. Since there was not a quorum, the commission members in attendance used the time available to discuss the Strength,

Weakness, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) Analysis framework to evaluate ICSSBM's competitive position and to develop our strategic plan. *The discussed SWOT analysis is included in the meeting minutes as Attachment A.*

Unfinished Business: Chair Jones provided an update on items that Commission members had questions on regarding the Per Diem process, Commission members that are allowed to vote, and the status of the annual report.

New Business: Chair Jones informed the Commission members on the 2024 meeting schedule.
