Primary and secondary 1-hour ozone standards were established in February 1979 at a level of 0.12 parts per million (ppm) ([44 FR 8202](#)). All other Indiana counties not listed above were designated “unclassifiable/attainment” under the 1-hour ozone standard.

**On March 9, 1993, after reviewing available science, U.S. EPA concluded that the standards provided the requisite level of public health and welfare protection, and, therefore retained the original standards ([58 FR 13008](#)).**

**All areas except Lake and Porter counties were in attainment of the 1-hour ozone standard when it was revoked on July 26, 2005 ([70 FR 44470](#)).**

**Attainment of the 1-hour ozone standard was determined by evaluating maximum hourly average concentrations at each monitor within a nonattainment area over each year. Attainment was met when the expected number of days per calendar year with maximum hourly average concentrations above 0.12 ppm, when averaged over three years, was equal to or less than 1.**
