



Initial Notification / Notification of Compliance Status Report for Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Facilities

Applicable Rules: 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart HHHHHH — National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants: Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating at Area Sources, and 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart A — National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories, Subpart A — General Provisions. Initial notification is being made in accordance with §63.9(b).

You may use the Application for Approval of Construction and Reconstruction as your initial notification. (§63.5(d)(1)(ii)).
