### **Transfer of Ownership**

Pursuant to 327 IAC 5-2-6(c), the parties have notified the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) of their intention to transfer IWP Permit INP000679 from American Landmaster, the "current permittee" and previous owner of the facility, to QuikCut, LLC, the "transferee" and future owner of the facility, effective as of November 3, 2025.

The transferee certifies that it is its intention to operate the facility for which IWP Permit INP000679 is issued without making such material and substantial alterations to the facility as would significantly change the nature or quantities of pollutants discharged, and thus constitute cause for permit modification under 327 IAC 5-2-16(d).
