Food Waste.PNG

#KnowYourNos - Keep food waste out of your recycling bin!

#KnowYourNos - Keep napkins, paper towels, and tissues out of the #recycling bin! If the plastic packaging they came in is dry and clean, you can recycle it at your local retailer.

#KnowYourNos - Keep tanglers out! Hoses, cords, and holiday lights can tangle up and damage #recycling equipment. When in doubt, throw it out!
