

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF COMPLETE APPLICATION

On May 18, 2020, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) received an application for a new solid waste processing facility from Caldwell's, Inc. at 822 East Industrial Drive, Morristown, 46161. IDEM has determined the application is now complete, including the initial submittal dated May 9, 2020, (VFC #[82973510](#)) and additional information dated July 22, 2020 (VFC #[83013671](#)). It is available online via IDEM's Virtual File Cabinet (VFC). Please go to: <http://vfc.idem.in.gov/>. You can view the documents there by going to "Alternate Field," selecting "Document ID," then entering one of the VFC numbers above in the "ID #" field. You may also select "Solid Waste (SW) Program ID" and enter the plans' SW Program ID number, 73-009, which will bring up a list of all related documents. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the library may be closed or have limited access, or the application could not be placed there. You may comment during the 30-day public comment period initiated by this notice within the following timeframes: 33 days after the date of the postmark on the envelope this notice came in, if it was mailed to you; 30 days after the date IDEM emailed you the notice, if it was emailed to you; or 30 days after the date an IDEM representative handed you the notice, if it was personally served to you. You may request that IDEM hold a public hearing. If a public hearing is held, IDEM will make a separate announcement of the date, time, and location of that hearing. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the ability to hold a public hearing may be delayed or prohibited. With this notice, IDEM initiates a period during which the public may submit comments regarding the application.

Following the end of the public comment period, IDEM will issue a Notice of Decision (NOD) stating whether the approval has been issued or denied. If comments are received during the public comment period, the final decision will include a document that summarizes the comments and IDEM's response to those comments. If you have submitted comments or have asked to be added to the mailing list, you will receive the NOD. The notice will provide details on how you may appeal IDEM's decision, if you disagree with that decision. The final decision will also be available online via the Virtual File Cabinet, and at the Shelby County Public Library, subject to the possible limitations noted above due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Public comments and supporting documentation, or a request for a public hearing should be sent in writing to IDEM at the address below. Email is preferred. If you do not want to comment at this time, but would like to receive notice of future action related to this permit application, please contact IDEM at the address below.
