

On March 31, 2022, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) Solid Waste Permits Section received an application for a modification to a Land Application Permit from Bio Town Ag, Inc. at 402 West 100 North, Reynolds, IN. This application requests the addition of 25 new land application sites, located in Newton and White Counties, to the current land application program and requests the option of finding and using other fields (sites) not listed in their permit (nonsite-specific sites) located in Benton and Newton Counties.
