

On June 3, 2022, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) Solid Waste Permits Section received an application for a Land Application Permit from Mid-States Specialty Eggs of Middlebury, LLC at 13519 County Road 20, Middlebury, IN. The application is a request to allow the land application of pollutant-bearing water (consisting of egg wash water) at agronomic rates to farmland in Elkhart County.
