Our office received your Notice of Intent (NOI) submittal on December 16, 2023, requesting renewal of NPDES general permit coverage for the above-referenced facility. We are pleased to inform you that the submittal is sufficient to comply with the NOI requirements for 327 IAC 15-7 and that general permit coverage for this mine will be renewed.

We have reviewed your request and have determined that the activities associated with it will not violate the antidegradation rules as set forth in 327 IAC 2-1.3. Our office has further determined that the request will not affect this facility's eligibility for coverage under the general permit rules outlined in 327 IAC 15-1 through 15-4 and 327 IAC 15-7, Facilities Engaged in Mining of Coal, Coal Processing, and Reclamation Activities. Therefore, your petition to obtain permit coverage as is described in your NOI has been approved in accordance with Indiana rules promulgated under 327 IAC15-7 and 327 IAC 2-1.3. Coverage for the facility will include all outfalls listed on the first table of Attachment 1 to this correspondence.

The NPDES general permit identification number assigned to this facility is referenced above. This renewal of NPDES general permit coverage for this facility <u>will</u> <u>become effective on April 1, 2024.</u> You are required to continue following all terms and conditions of 327 IAC 15-7. The new expiration date is <u>March 31, 2029</u>. In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the date of expiration, you must submit a renewal NOI to IDEM no later than ninety (90) days prior to the date of expiration.

One condition of your permit requires periodic reporting of several effluent parameters. You are required to submit both federal discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) and state Monthly Monitoring Reports (MMRs) on a routine basis. The MMR form can be found on IDEM's website at https://www.in.gov/idem/cleanwater/wastewater-compliance/wastewater-reporting-forms-notices-and-instructions/.

All NPDES permit holders are required to submit their monitoring data to IDEM using NetDMR. Please contact Helen Demmings (317) 232-8815 if you would like more information on NetDMR or see IDEM's website at https://www.in.gov/idem/cleanwater/resources/netdmr/. Also, all current agency rules, including the general NPDES permits-by-rule 327 IAC 15, are posted at https://www.in.gov/idem/legal/environmental-laws-and-rules/.

The effluent limitations and monitoring requirements at this site differ from the standard monitoring requirements found in 327 IAC 15-7-7 due to its location in a watershed listed on the 303(d) list of impaired watersheds, so <u>additional sampling parameters will continue to be required.</u> Please provide appropriate data on the reports mentioned above.

Please note that IDEM is required to serve notice of its decision to accept your facility for renewal of coverage under the general permit in accordance with the requirements of 327 IAC 5-3-14. It should also be noted that any appeal must be filed under procedures outlined in IC 13-15-6, IC 4-21.5, and the enclosed Public Notice. The appeal must be initiated by filing a petition for administrative review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) within fifteen (15) days of the emailing of an electronic copy of this letter or within eighteen (18) days of the mailing of this letter. - [1] In addition to the effluent limitations and monitoring requirements contained in Tables 1 and 2 of this authorization letter, the permittee must also ensure that all discharges comply with the Minimum Narrative Water Quality Standards as set forth in 327 IAC 15-7-7(b).
- [2] The permittee shall measure and report the identified metal in <u>total recoverable form.</u>
- [3] A minimum of one sample shall be collected, analyzed, and the results reported each calendar quarter. The monitoring results shall be reported on the March, June, September, and December DMR forms. The MMRs shall denote the actual day(s) on which the monitoring occurred. After a minimum of ten (10) quarters of sampling data have been completed, the permittee may submit a written request to IDEM to review this monitoring data for potential reduction or elimination of these monitoring requirements.
- [4] Monitoring and sampling are required when discharging. For months during which there is no discharge from a permitted outfall, the MMR/DMR should state "No discharge".
- [5] The permittee has stated that the dry weather base flow value for these outfalls is zero (0) cfs. The dry weather base flow is the normal base flow coming from an area or treatment facility which is not immediately affected by runoff caused by rainfall or a snowmelt. This flow is the result of ground water interference or a build-up of rainwater over a long period of time. The permittee may choose to apply the alternate effluent limitations set forth in 327 IAC 15-7-7(c) to a discharge (in lieu of the limits in Table 1) when the discharge flow rate exceeds the dry weather base flow based upon the precipitation events described therein.

UNITED MINERALS LLC - SEVEN HILLS MINE, NPDES General Permit Coverage No. ING040290, located at 9200 W CR 750N, Elberfeld, IN (WARRICK COUNTY). The permittee has submitted a complete Notice of Intent requesting renewal of NPDES general permit coverage under 327 IAC 15-7. All outfalls are regulated as a part of existing DNR permit S-00357. There continue to be seven (7) permitted outfalls, five (5) of which are active and discharge into unnamed tributaries to Pigeon Creek. Two additional outfalls are not yet constructed. The permitted outfalls, including their locations and mine drainage status, are listed in Attachment 1 to the approval letter. Notice of Right to Administrative Review

If you wish to challenge this permit action, you must file a Petition for Administrative Review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) and serve a copy of the petition upon IDEM. The requirements for filing a Petition for Administrative Review are found in IC 4-21.5-3-7, IC 13-15-6-1 and 315 IAC 1-3-2. A summary of the requirements of these laws is provided below.

A Petition for Administrative Review must be filed with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this notice (eighteen (18) days if you received this notice by U.S. Mail), and a copy must be served upon IDEM. Addresses are:

The petition must contain the following information:

- 1. The name, address and telephone number of each petitioner.
- 2. A description of each petitioner's interest in the permit.
- 3. A statement of facts demonstrating that each petitioner is:
 - a. a person to whom the order is directed;
 - b. aggrieved or adversely affected by the permit; or
 - c. entitled to administrative review under any law.
- 4. The reasons for the request for administrative review.
- 5. The particular legal issues proposed for review.
- 6. The alleged environmental concerns or technical deficiencies of the permit.
- 7. The permit terms and conditions that the petitioner believes would be appropriate and would comply with the law.
- 8. The identity of any persons represented by the petitioner.
- 9. The identity of the person against whom administrative review is sought.
- 10. A copy of the permit that is the basis of the petition.

11. A statement identifying petitioner's attorney or other representative, if any.

Failure to meet the requirements of the law with respect to a Petition for Administrative Review may result in a waiver of your right to seek administrative review of the permit. Examples of these include the following:

- 1. Failure to file a Petition by the applicable deadline;
- 2. Failure to serve a copy of the Petition upon IDEM when it is filed; or
- 3. Failure to include the information required by law.

If you seek to have a permit stayed during the administrative review, you may need to file a Petition for a Stay of Effectiveness. The specific requirements for such a Petition can be found in 315 IAC 1-3-2 and 315 IAC 1-3-2.1.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-17, OEA will provide all parties with notice of any pre-hearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearings, stays, or orders disposing of the review of this action. If you are entitled to notice under IC 4-21.5-3-5(b) and would like to obtain notices of any pre-hearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearings, stays, or orders disposing of the review of this action without intervening in the proceeding you must submit a written request to OEA at the address above.

An appeal must be postmarked no later than fifteen (15) days from the date of this public notice. Such a written request for an adjudicatory hearing must:

- (A) state the name and address of the person making the request;
- (B) identify the interest of the person making the request;
- (C) identify any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (D) state with particularity the reasons for the request;
- (E) state with particularity the issues proposed for consideration at the hearing; and
- (F) state with particularity the reasons why the NPDES general permit rule should not be available to the discharger identified in this notice.
