The Office of Water Quality proposes the following DRAFT NPDES PERMIT:

Minor Modification:

Town of Elizabethtown WWTP, Permit IN0039349, BARTHOLOMEW COUNTY, 120 West Street, Elizabethtown, IN. This minor municipal wastewater treatment plant has an average design flow of 0.06477 million gallons daily of treated sanitary wastewater into an unnamed tributary to Cooks Creek via Outfall 001. Outfall 001 is located at Latitude: 39° 08' 17" N, Longitude: 85° 49' 05" W. Sludge at the facility is hauled offsite. The permittee requests a permit modification to reduce the sampling frequency of CBOD₅, TSS, and Ammonia-Nitrogen from two (2) times weekly to once (1) weekly. The Department will determine whether to hold a public hearing based upon the comments and the rationale for the request. Public Notice of such a hearing will be posted on IDEM's web site for public notices and notification will also be sent out to those persons submitting comments and/or on the mailing list at least 30 days prior to the hearing.

AMENDED AUTHORIZATION TO DISCHARGE UNDER THE
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM

In compliance with the provisions of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq., the "Clean Water Act") or (CWA), and IDEMs authority under IC 13-5, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) is issuing this permit to the

TOWN OF ELIZABETHTOWN

hereinafter referred to as "the permittee." The permittee owns and/or operates the **Town of Elizabethtown Wastewater Treatment Plant**, a minor municipal wastewater treatment plant located at 120 West Street, Elizabethtown, Indiana, Bartholomew County. The permittee is hereby authorized to discharge from the outfalls identified in Part I of this permit to receiving waters consisting of an unnamed tributary to Cooks Creek in accordance with the effluent limitations, monitoring requirements, and other conditions set forth in the permit. This permit may be revoked for the nonpayment of applicable fees in accordance with IC 13-18-20.

The permit, as issued on September 19, 2024 is hereby amended as contained herein. The amended provisions shall become effective on _____. All terms and conditions of the permit not modified at this time remain in effect. Further, any existing condition or term affected by the modifications will remain in effect until the modified provisions become effective.

This permit and authorization to discharge, as amended, shall expire at midnight, September 30, 2029. In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the date of expiration, the permittee shall submit such information and forms as are required by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management no later than 180 days prior to the date of expiration.

TREATMENT FACILITY DESCRIPTION

The permittee currently operates a Class I, 0.06477 MGD concentric package type extended aeration treatment facility consisting of an influent pump station, an influent screen, an excess flow pump station flow equalization tank, a return flow pump station, an aeration tank, a secondary clarifier, a wet weather equalization basin, ultraviolet light (UV) disinfection, diffused post aeration, and an effluent flow meter. The biosolids are treated in an aerobic digester and then are hauled off site by a licensed contractor. The facility does not contain an influent flow meter.

The collection system is comprised of 100% separate sanitary sewers by design with two (2) Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) points.

PART I

A. EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS AND MONITORING REQUIREMENTS

The permittee is authorized to discharge from the outfall listed below in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit. The permittee shall take samples and measurements at a location representative of each discharge to determine whether the effluent limitations have been met. Refer to Part I.B of this permit for additional monitoring and reporting requirements.

- Beginning on the effective date of this permit, the permittee is authorized to discharge from Outfall 001, which is located at Latitude: 39° 08' 17" N, Longitude: 85° 49' 05" W. The discharge is subject to the following requirements:

Background

This is the modification of the NPDES permit for the Town of Elizabethtown Wastewater Treatment Plant. The facility's current permit was effective on October 1, 2024 and has an expiration date of September 30, 2029. A request for permit modification was received from the permittee on November 17, 2025. The permittee requests a permit modification to reduce the sampling frequency of CBOD₅, TSS, and Ammonia-Nitrogen from two (2) times weekly to once (1) weekly.

Modification

The following changes have been made for the modification of the NPDES permit:

Page 1 of 32 This page has been modified to reflect the modification effective date for the permit.

Page 2 of 32 This page has been modified to reflect the modification of sampling frequency requirements for CBOD₅, TSS, and Ammonia-Nitrogen from two (2) times weekly to once (1) weekly in Table 1. This reduction is based on the permittee's ability to demonstrate compliance with the parameters for the past year.

Expiration Date

The expiration date of the permit has not changed. The permit, as modified, will expire at midnight on September 30, 2029.
