The Office of Water Quality proposes the following DRAFT IWP PERMIT:

MINOR – MODIFICATION:

MEG 2 LLC fka ORG Chem Group LLC, Permit No. INP000046, PERRY COUNTY, 11210 Solomon Road, Troy, IN. This facility processes and recycle industrial fluids such as ethylene glycol, propylene glycol, and glycerin using vacuum distillation, wipe film evaporation and/or column distillation. The permittee informed IDEM on December 30, 2025 that a transfer of ownership was completed on January 17, 2025. This information has been verified with the Indiana Secretary of State's Office. The written request shall include: the name and address of the person making the request, the interest of the person making the request, persons represented by the person making the request, the reason for the request and the issues proposed for consideration at the hearing. The Department will determine whether to hold a public hearing based upon the comments and rationale for the request. Public Notice of such a hearing will be posted on IDEM's web site and will be transmitted to those persons submitting comments and/or on the mailing list at least 30 days prior to the hearing.

AMENDED AUTHORIZATION TO DISCHARGE UNDER THE
INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER PRETREATMENT PROGRAM

INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER PRETREATMENT (IWP) PERMIT

In accordance with 327 IAC 5-21 and IDEM's permitting authority under IC 13-15, **MEG 2, LLC** (hereinafter referred to as the permittee) is authorized to discharge, from the facility located at 11210 Solomon Road, Troy, Indiana into the **Tell City Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW)**, in accordance with the effluent limitations, monitoring requirements, and other conditions set forth in Parts I and II hereof.

The permit, as issued on December 4, 2024 is hereby amended, as contained herein. The amended provisions shall become effective _____. All terms and conditions of the permit not modified at this time remain in effect. Further, any existing condition or term affected by the amendments will remain in effect until the amended provisions become effective. This permit and the authorization to discharge, as amended, shall expire at midnight December 31, 2029.

NOTE: In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the date of expiration, the permittee must submit a renewal IWP permit application to the Industrial NPDES Permit Section in the Office of Water Quality, no later than one hundred and eighty (180) days prior to the date this permit expires. Failure to do so will result in expiration of the authorization to discharge.

Transfer of Ownership

Pursuant to 327 IAC 5-2-6(c), the parties have notified the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) of their intention to transfer IWP Permit INP000046 from ORG Chem Group, LLC the "current permittee" and previous owner of the facility, to MEG 2, LLC, the "transferee" and future owner of the facility, effective as of January 17, 2025.

The current permittee acknowledges liability for violations up to the proposed date of permit transfer, and the transferee acknowledges liability for violations on and after the proposed date of permit transfer.

The transferee certifies that it is its intention to operate the facility for which IWP Permit INP000046 is issued without making such material and substantial alterations to the facility as would significantly change the nature or quantities of pollutants discharged, and thus constitute cause for permit modification under 327 IAC 5-2-16(d).
