

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Permits Section will be holding a Public Hearing on March 16<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM at the Morristown Jr. Sr. Highschool Cafeteria, 223 S Patterson St, Morristown, IN 46161. The purpose of said hearing is to allow public input regarding the proposed vertical expansion of the Crossroads Eco-Center Landfill dated August 29, 2024, and submitted September 5, 2024. At said hearing, all interested parties may submit written or oral statements to the Hearing Officer for consideration.

#### Procedures for the Formulation of Final Determination

##### Comment Period:

The major modification permit application was available and open for public comment from November 26, 2025, through January 6, 2026.
