The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has received an application for a construction permit from the CITIZENS WATER INDIANAPOLIS, public water system 5249004, this project is described as the Citizens Lebanon Water Supply. The current project, also known as Project F4, is located in Boone County, Indiana. The project is an Addendum to the Citizens Lebanon Water Supply Program Project F3 and begins at the intersection of 200 E and 400 S. The proposed water main runs east along 400 S and continues south along 300 E. If approved the permit will become effective on the date of issuance.
