

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF COMPLETE APPLICATION

On December 17, 2025, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) received an application for a major permit modification from Best Way of Indiana, Inc. to construct a second transfer station building at 5350 Rock Hampton Court in Marion County. During the comment period, you may request that IDEM hold a public hearing. If a public hearing is held, IDEM will make a separate announcement of the date, time, and location of the hearing. Comments and supporting documentation, or a request for a public hearing should be sent in writing to IDEM at the address above. Email is preferred. If you do not want to comment at this time but would like to receive notice of future action related to this permit application.

Following the end of the public comment period, IDEM will issue a Notice of Decision (NOD) stating whether the approval has been issued or denied. If comments are received during the public notice period, the final decision will include a document that summarizes the comments and IDEM's response to those comments. If you have submitted comments or have asked to be added to the mailing list, you will receive the NOD. The notice will provide details on how you may appeal IDEM's decision, if you disagree with that decision. The final decision will also be available online via the Virtual File Cabinet, at the address indicated above.
