

On August 03, 2026, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) Solid Waste Permits Section received an application for a modification to a Land Application of Industrial Process Wastewater permit from Rose Acre Farms, Inc. at 1657 West Tipton Street, Seymour, IN, 47274. The current permit allows Cort Acre Egg Farm to land apply industrial process wastewater (egg breaking and egg grading wash water) to site specific sites in Jackson County. The application is a request to expand permitted field CA001 and requests equivalent methods to the setback requirements for surface waters Jackson County.

The notice will provide details on how you may appeal IDEM's decision if you disagree with that decision.
