¹ Calculated by IDEM using landfill's current contour update map. Landfills are surveyed between December 1 & March 31. Gross airspace is calculated as top of current waste level to top of approved final cover layer. If a landfill contains future undeveloped areas, subgrade elevation levels are used in airspace calculation. Calculations assume 30" clay liner for approved undeveloped (future) areas. Current & undeveloped area volumes are added to attain total gross airspace.

² Equal to gross airspace minus volume of final cover & intermediate & daily cover. Final cover volume is estimated as total future & current area multiplied by a 5ft final cover. IDEM assumes waste airspace will consist of 15% daily & intermediate cover. Gross airspace minus final cover volume is multiplied by 85% to attain remaining capacity for waste only.

³ IDEM assumes future waste receipts remain at 2014 levels. Waste receipts in tons are converted to cubic yards using a conversion factor of 1.5 cubic yards/ton. Remaining capacity is divided by waste in cubic yards to estimate life.

⁴ Received minimal waste in 2014

⁵ Sullivan County landfill currently only accepts C/D waste in a 4.6 acre portion of the landfill. Per section B7 of the facility's permit renewal dated 4/4/2007, the landfill must submit a modification application to IDEM to develop any permitted undeveloped MSW areas.
